Judge Katherine D. Savage served as an Associate Judge on the Circuit Court for Montgomery County beginning in March of 2002. Previous to that, she sat on the District Court bench for five years. Before occupying the bench, she served as an Assistant and later as a Senior Assistant State's Attorney in Montgomery County for ten years. She began her legal career as an associate attorney with Catterton, Kemp & Mason in Rockville, Maryland.

Among other community and professional activities, Judge Savage was the chair of the Foster Care Court Improvement Project/Child Representation Subcommittee from 2006-2012. She is a past-president of the Montgomery County Women's Bar Association, as well as president of its Foundation. Judge Savage was a founding member of the Teen Court Project in Montgomery County.

Judge Savage graduated from the University of Maryland School of Law; she was a Teaching Fellow at Georgetown University, Department of History; and received a Master of Arts degree in American History from Rutgers University in New Jersey. Her undergraduate degree is from Seton Hall University.
