Note to Clerk: If the collateral pledged to secure the bond is a certificate of deposit, you must take possession of the instrument (certificate). If the instrument is NOT made payable to bearer, read the instrument to make sure it is assignable. The assignment form must be completed when either certificate of deposits or deposit accounts are taken as security for a bond. The assignment must be signed by the person presenting the instrument or pledging the account. A Bail Bond form (DC-CR-008) must also be completed. Store the original assignment form and instrument in the safe.
