General Information

The Maryland Judiciary began an important initiative to improve its responsiveness to families and children when it created circuit court family divisions and family services programs in 1998. Since that time, the circuit courts have reoriented their case management practices and developed programs to assist the many families and children that come before the court. The Maryland Judiciary is committed to ensuring that services provided by the courts are accessible to all litigants regardless of their ability to pay for the services, and without regard to representational status.

The Maryland Judiciary receives state funding each year to enhance the courts' ability to provide a fair and efficient forum for resolving domestic and juvenile matters. The Department of Family Administration (DFA) at the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) is requesting applications for Jurisdictional Family Services Grants. These grants are designed to establish and maintain family divisions within Maryland's larger circuit courts and to support family services programs within the smaller circuit courts. They are intended to assist the circuit courts in fulfilling the mandate of Maryland Rule 16-204.

Eligible Grantees

Eligible grantees include Maryland Circuit Courts or any governments administering Circuit Court Family Divisions or Family Services Programs in the state of Maryland.

Funding Period

July 1, 2011 – June 30, 2012
