Questions/Responses No. 1 to the Request for Proposals (RFP) K17-0030-94 Montgomery County Mental Health Courts Support

Ladies and Gentlemen:

The following questions for the above referenced RFP were received by e-mail and are answered and posted for all prospective Offerors. The statements and interpretations contained in the following responses to questions are not binding on the Maryland Judiciary unless the RFP is expressly amended. Nothing in the Maryland Judiciary's response to these questions is to be construed as agreement to or acceptance by the Maryland Judiciary of any statement or interpretation on the part of the Offeror asking the question.

Question: When do you anticipate the project to begin?
 Response: We would like both resources in place by November 2016.

2. Question: Are the candidates required to have judicial experience? Response: While it is not required, it is highly preferred.

3. Question: The RFP states that the candidates will support both District and Circuit Courts for Montgomery County. Will the selected candidate report to both locations?

Response: Yes, the selected candidate's primary place of work will be at Montgomery County District Court, however, there will be instances where they must report to Montgomery County Circuit Court. We estimate an 80/20 split between the two courts.
