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Ladies and Gentlemen:

The following questions for the above referenced RFP were received by e-mail and are answered and posted for all prospective Offerors who received the RFP. The statements and interpretations contained in the following responses to questions are not binding on the Maryland Judiciary unless the RFP is expressly amended. Nothing in the Maryland Judiciary's response to these questions is to be construed as agreement to or acceptance by the Maryland Judiciary of any statement or interpretation on the part of the Offeror asking the question.

1. Question: What is the number of cameras that the current JAVS Autolog system capable of monitoring and controlling at this time?

Response: Four.

2. Question: If additional cameras were added would this require reprogramming of the current system?

Response: Yes, however, the Judiciary would consider installing a new system if it provided enhanced functionality and improved performance.

3. Question: Are the existing 4 cameras identified by an IP address and are their addresses reassignable?

Response: Yes. Each camera has an IP address which can be reassigned.

4. Question: Will cabling for new requirements such as LAN drops and electrical outlets be done in-house?

Response: All Cat5 or Cat6 cable will be done in-house. Any other specialized cabling would be outsourced.
