ACCESS TO JUSTICE GRANTS

As part of its mission to provide fair, efficient, and effective justice for all, the Maryland Judiciary receives state funds each year to support programs that enhance access to justice. Access to Justice Grant funds are available for non-profit legal service providers to support programs that enhance access to legal representation in civil case types, and for Maryland state courts for certain court initiatives.

Grant Purpose

These grants are being offered to enhance the courts' ability to provide meaningful access to justice. The following types of projects will be considered for funding:

- 1. Access to Justice. Programs that enhance access to justice in civil legal matters. Successful programs will partner with a local court to enhance access to the courts or to facilitate the ability of persons without counsel to handle legal matters on their own.
- 2. Volunteer Lawyer of the Day Programs. Programs that provide access to a pro bono lawyer on the day of court for case types where such representation is appropriate including consumer and rent or other housing cases.
- 3. Language Access Initiatives. Programs that enhance access to justice for persons whose primary language is not English.

Eligible Applicants

- Maryland Circuit Courts
- Non-Profit Organizations
- Institutions of Higher Education

Availability and Awards of Funds

The availability of funds is contingent upon the provision of funds in the Maryland Judiciary budget by the Maryland General Assembly for Fiscal Year 2020. Applicants who are awarded funding will receive notice in early June of 2020.
