NORMAL COURT FUNCTIONS

As the emergency period under the COVID-19 pandemic has subsided, and having adopted Chief Judge Barbera's five revised Administrative Orders issued on February 16, 2021 regarding the COVID-19 public health emergency and Court operations as well this Courts Administrative Order 21-06

It is therefore, by the Circuit Court of Queen Anne's County, hereby **ORDERED**:

- 1) The Queen Anne's County Circuit Court will move to Phase V, full operations, on April 26, 2021, including the resumption of jury trials; and
- 2) Health protocols will continue to be required, including the wearing of masks, handwashing, sanitizing, temperature checks, and maintaining social distancing; and
- 3) Remote proceedings shall continue, as well as limitations on the number of people in the building, to the extent necessary to protect the staff and general public from potential exposure to COVID-19; and
- 4) This Order shall rescind any prior Orders related to restricted operations that may be inconsistent with this Order. Administrative Order 20-13 regarding pre-filed exhibits is not rescinded and shall continue to be effect.
