MDEC

The Maryland Electronic Courts (MDEC) case management system will expand to Western Maryland on October 16, 2017.

The MDEC launch will mean the start of mandatory e-filing for attorneys filing cases in the District Court and the Circuit Courts in Allegany, Frederick, Garrett, and Washington counties, as well as appellate filings that commence in those counties.

In order to begin e-filing, you must register with the MDEC system. Please note the following dates to attend a registration fair near you:

Who should attend?

Firm administrators:

Each firm/agency MUST have a designated person to administer the e-filing system. The administrator will register the firm and be responsible for setting up and maintaining all users, credit card accounts, and attorneys/ paralegals at the firm. Firm administrators MUST invite all firm users to join MDEC through email.

Attorneys, Paralegals, Auditors and Examiners:

Once your firm has registered on MDEC, your firm administrator will be able to send you an email invitation to join. Remember to ask your firm administrator to invite you to join.



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
