Key Components of Successful Proposals

- Identify Target Population
- Statement of Need and Benefits
- Demonstrated Impact- Why this proposal will meet the stated need
- ► Timeline for Activities and Impact: Short term or long term
- Operational Considerations
 - Example:
 - Case Selection Criteria
 - Referral Mechanisms
 - Training needs

 - ► Smart Goals:
 - **Specific**
 - **►**Measurable
 - **► A**chievable
 - **▶** Relevant
 - ▶Time Bound
