

Court of Appeals

The Court of Appeals is Maryland's highest court. It was created by the Constitution of 1776. The Court has seven judges, representing the seven appellate judicial circuits. Cases heard by the Court of Appeals originate almost exclusively by way of certiorari, a discretionary review process. The Court grants those petitions for certiorari it deems to be desirable and in the public interest. The Court may review cases already decided by the Court of Special Appeals or bring up for review cases filed in that Court before they are decided. The Court of Appeals has exclusive jurisdiction over appeals in which a sentence of death is imposed. Other functions include adopting rules of judicial administration, practice and procedure; admitting persons to the practice of law; and conducting disciplinary proceedings involving members of the bench and bar.



6 Year Comparative Data Fiscal Years 2000 - 2005




CHART CA-1.2 COURT OF APPEALS

6 Year Comparative Data Fiscal Years 2000 - 2005



REGULAR DOCKET 2004 Term



APPEALS DOCKETED BY TERM 1999 - 2004 Terms



FILINGS AND DISPOSITIONS Fiscal Year 2005



DISPOSITION OF CIVIL APPEALS Fiscal Year 2005




CHART CA-5.2 COURT OF APPEALS

DISPOSITION OF CRIMINAL APPEALS Fiscal Year 2005




CHART CA-5.3 COURT OF APPEALS

DISPOSITION OF ALL APPEALS Fiscal Year 2005



TOTAL NUMBER CIVIL PETITIONS FOR CERTIORARI DISPOSED




CHART CA-6.2 COURT OF APPEALS

TOTAL NUMBER CIVIL PETITIONS FOR CERTIORARI DOCKETED Manner of Disposition




CHART CA-6.3 COURT OF APPEALS

TOTAL NUMBER CRIMINAL PETITIONS FOR CERTIORARI DISPOSED




CHART CA-6.4 COURT OF APPEALS

TOTAL NUMBER CRIMINAL PETITIONS FOR CERTIORARI DOCKETED Manner of Disposition


