Questions/Responses No. 1 to the Request for Proposals (RFP) K18-0026-25D Judicial College Long Term Technical Trainer for the Technology Education Department

Ladies and Gentlemen:

The following questions for the above referenced RFP were received by the procurement officer and are answered and posted for all prospective Offerors. The statements and interpretations contained in the following responses to questions are not binding on the Maryland Judiciary unless the RFP is expressly amended. Nothing in the Maryland Judiciary's response to these questions is to be construed as agreement to or acceptance by the Maryland Judiciary of any statement or interpretation on the part of the Offeror asking the question.

- 1) Question:** The Instructor position under this RFP calls for a 4 year college degree. MD State always allows substitution of Degree by number of years of hands on experience in appropriate technology and as a Maryland State Agency, would JECC allow that? There may be highly skilled certified professionals with great technical background and experience to fit into the position but may not have a 4 year college degree. Would you consider such candidates?

Response: Yes, JECC prefers a long term technical trainer with a four-year college degree. However; candidates with substitution of Degree by number of years of hands on experience in the appropriate technology areas will be considered.
