procedures, defenses, and proceedings for reopening, vacating, staying, enforcing or satisfying as a judgment of this court pursuant to Section 11-802 of the Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland. If the judgment debtor shows the court that an appeal from the foreign judgment is pending or will be taken, or that a stay of execution has been granted and proves that the judgment debtor has furnished the security for the satisfaction of
