MOTION AND ORDER COMPELLING ANSWERS TO INTERROGATORIES IN AID OF EXECUTION (Md. Rules 3-633(a) and 3-634(c))

NOTE: A person may not be compelled to appear in person for an examination or to answer interrogatories in order to enforce a money judgment resulting from a small claims action (amount sued for was \$5,000 or less, exclusive of interest, costs, and attorney's fees).
