CLERKSHIPS

Chief Justice Fader employs two law clerks, who typically serve a one-year term beginning in mid-August. The chief justice reviews applications from law school graduates and law students who have received at least three semesters of grades.

Chief Justice Fader is currently not accepting term law clerk applications.

INTERNSHIPS

Chief Justice Fader accepts applications from law students for unpaid judicial internships for the fall, spring, and summer semesters. Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis.

Internship applicants should submit a cover letter, resume, law school transcript (official or unofficial), a list of references, and one writing sample. Please note in the cover letter whether you are pursuing the internship for academic credit and any requirements for you to receive credit.
