OCTOBER 2020 REMOTE BAR EXAM IN MARYLAND

Information on Score Transfers To Reciprocal Jurisdictions and Opt-Out Form

<u>Score transfers available</u> - Prior to the October 2020 Remote Bar Exam, the State Board of Law Examiners (SBLE) reached reciprocal agreements for the transfer of remote bar exam scores with admissions authorities in Connecticut, District of Columbia, Illinois, Kentucky, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Oregon, Tennessee, and Vermont. In addition, admissions authorities in Texas announced that Texas would accept transfers of the results of the October 2020 Remote Bar Exam from Maryland (although Maryland cannot accept score transfers from Texas, which did not give a UBE-like exam).

Score transfer procedure - Within about a week of the release of results for Maryland's administration of the October remote exam, SBLE will report to reciprocal jurisdictions the full name, NCBE number and exam scores of each individual whose score on the October 2020 Remote Bar Exam in Maryland constitutes a qualifying score in the receiving jurisdiction: Connecticut (≥266), District of Columbia (≥266), Illinois (≥266), Kentucky (≥264), Massachusetts (≥270), New Hampshire (≥270), New Jersey (≥266), New York (≥266), Ohio (≥270), Oregon (≥266), Tennessee (≥270), Texas (≥270), and Vermont (≥270).

<u>Option to OPT OUT; Procedure</u> – The default policy will be to report all qualifying scores to each reciprocal jurisdiction. Examinees may <u>OPT OUT</u> of having their results shared with other jurisdictions by completing the Opt-Out form below and submitting it by email to <u>SBLE@mdcourts.gov</u> no later than NOON on Tuesday, <u>December 1, 2020.</u> Applicants wishing to have their scores reported DO NOT need to return a form.

- Please note that by completing and returning the opt-out form, examinees are opting out of the transfer of
 exam results to ALL reciprocal jurisdictions. (An applicant's score will either be sent to all reciprocal
 jurisdictions where it qualifies, or the score will not be sent to any jurisdictions.)
- Applicants who opt out of sharing their October 2020 remote exam score will not be permitted to transfer this score at a later date.
