**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER – MARRIAGE ROOM**

Pursuant to the five (5) separate Amended Administrative Orders dated May 24, 2021 by the Honorable Mary Ellen Barbera, Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals of Maryland, it is this 7<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2021, by the Circuit Court for Washington County, Maryland, **ORDERED**,

that upon rescission/expiration of Governor Hogan’s **Executive Order 2020-05-13-02: *Enabling Alternative Processes for Marriage Applications and Ceremonies*** or at such time as the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Washington County determines that in-person civil ceremonies can resume, the number of persons permitted in the Marriage Room (#115) will be limited to the two (2) parties being married and the Clerk performing the ceremony, and it is further **ORDERED**,

that unvaccinated participants shall be required to wear a mask, without vents, to properly cover their nose, mouth and chin completely while in the building, to include at all times during the civil ceremony.
