ORDER

By the Court's April 10, 2007 Order, attorney Carlos B. Z. Smith (AIS No. 0006210398) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rule 19-605. Attorney Smith has now requested reinstatement pursuant to Rule 19-606(c), and the Trustees of the Client Protection Fund have confirmed attorney Smith's compliance with Rule 19-605.

By the Court's March 20, 2025 Order, attorney Marshall W. Taylor (AIS No. 0106210012) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-409(c). Attorney Taylor has now requested reinstatement pursuant to those Rules, and the Administrative Office of the Courts has confirmed attorney Taylor's compliance with Rules 19-409(c).

Accordingly, it is this 19th day of May 2025, by the Supreme Court of Maryland,
ORDERED that attorneys

Carlos B. Z. Smith (AIS No. 0006210398), and

Marshall W. Taylor (AIS No. 0106210012)

are restored to good standing by the Court and are again permitted to practice law in the State of Maryland; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall send notice in accordance with Rule 19-761.
