ORDER

By the Court's March 20, 2014 Order, attorney Khalilah M. Harris (AIS No. 0612120375) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rule 19-605. Attorney Harris has now requested reinstatement pursuant to Rule 19-606(c), and the Trustees of the Client Protection Fund have confirmed attorney Harris's compliance with Rule 19-605.

Accordingly, it is this 9th day of September 2025, by the Supreme Court of Maryland,

ORDERED that attorney Khalilah M. Harris (AIS No.0612120375) is restored to good standing by the Court and is again permitted to practice law in the State of Maryland; and it is further
