The State Board of Law Examiners (the “Board”), after careful consideration of their qualifications, has, pursuant to Rule 19-211(b)(1), recommended that each applicant named on Exhibit A to this order be admitted to the Maryland Bar, conditioned upon each applicant’s satisfaction of the requirements of Maryland Rules 19-204 (Character Review), 19-212 (Maryland Law Component), and 19-213 (Qualifying MPRE Score).

Based on the Board’s report and recommendation, it is this 6th day of January 2023, by the Supreme Court of Maryland,

ORDERED that, subject to the conditions stated above, the Board’s recommendation will be ratified as to each listed applicant on the 6th day of February 2023 unless exceptions to the Board’s recommendation to admit that applicant are filed with the Court before that date; and it is further

ORDERED that, pursuant to Rule 19-211(b)(2), a copy of this Order shall be posted on the Judiciary website within five days of the date of this Order and shall remain posted on the website until the Board’s recommendation is ratified.
