State Board has completed the action required by Rule 19-216(e) and who have satisfied the

requirements of Rule 19-212 (Maryland Law Component) and 19-213 (Qualifying MPRE Score

Required), will be admitted to practice law in this Court upon taking the oath prescribed by the

statute.
