

Online Application Announcement

The Supreme Court of Maryland is pleased to announce the opening of two (2) vacancies on the Character Committee for the Third Appellate Judicial Circuit from Howard County. Character Committees are appointed by the Supreme Court of Maryland in the seven Appellate Judicial Circuits to review the character and fitness of most applicants for admission to the Maryland bar. The Character Committees are made up of volunteer Maryland attorneys who investigate and interview these applicants, and, when necessary, hold hearings as to their character and fitness. The Character Committees then make recommendations to the State Board of Law Examiners regarding the applicants' character and fitness for admission to the Maryland bar. The work of the Character Committees is an important component of the bar admissions process.
