ORDER
(Corrected)

By the Court's March 25, 2021, Order, attorney Brandon C. Mumby (AIS No. 1612140118) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-503 and 19-605. Attorney Mumby has now requested reinstatement pursuant to Rules 19-503(c) and 19-606(c), and the Administrative Office of the Courts and Trustees of the Client Protection Fund have confirmed attorney Mumby's compliance with Rules 19-503 and 19-605.

By the Court's March 24, 2022, Order, attorneys Samuel H. Paavola (AIS No. 7512010240) and Jonathan G. Cedarbaum (AIS No. 9712160117) were prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-503 and 19-605. Attorney Paavola and Cedarbaum have now requested reinstatement pursuant to Rules 19-503(c) and 19-606(c), and the Administrative Office of the Courts and Trustees of the Client Protection Fund have confirmed attorneys Paavola's and Cedarbaum's compliance with Rules 19-503 and 19-605.

Accordingly, pursuant to Rules 19-503(c)(6) and 19-606(c)(2), it is this 31st day of January 2023, by the Court of Appeals of Maryland,

ORDERED that attorneys:

Brandon C. Mumby (AIS No. 1612140118),

Samuel H. Paavola (AIS No. 7512010240), and

Jonathan G. Cedarbaum (AIS No. 9712160117)

are restored to good standing by the Court and are again permitted to practice law in the State of Maryland; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Clerk of the Appellate Court of Maryland, the clerks of the circuit courts for the counties and Baltimore City, the Chief Clerk of District Court of Maryland, the Clerk of the Supreme Court of the United States, the Clerk of the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit, and the Clerk of the United States District Court for the District of Maryland.
