

HOWARD COUNTY RENTAL ASSISTANCE AND EVICTION PREVENTION

July 6, 2020: **Howard County residents** may apply for **rental or mortgage assistance**. It may cover up to three months of housing expenses.

To apply, you will need

1. Proof of where you live.
2. Evidence of income loss due to COVID – may be due to the loss of a job, a reduction in hours, and/or days missed because someone was sick
