

**IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF MARYLAND

ORDER ON THE REOPENING OF
“OLD” CATONSVILLE DISTRICT COURT AT
900 WALKER AVENUE, CATONSVILLE, MD 21228**

WHEREAS, Governor Lawrence Hogan has issued a “Proclamation and Declaration of State of Emergency and Existence of Catastrophic Health Emergency - COVID – 19”;

WHEREAS, Due to the outbreak of the novel coronavirus, COVID-19, and consistent with guidance issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Maryland Department of Health (MDH), an emergency exists for which measures continue to be required to mitigate the potential for exposure of court personnel and individuals visiting the court;

WHEREAS, The COVID-19 emergency continues, though restrictions are being eased in parts of Maryland and throughout Baltimore County, and requires the Judiciary to implement a phased approach to progress from emergency functions, while employing safety measures and monitoring local health conditions to support the health and safety of court personnel and individuals visiting the court;

WHEREAS, The Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals has issued the Amended Administrative Order on the Progressive Resumption of Full Function of Judiciary Operations Previously Restricted Due to the COVID-19 Emergency (“the Amended Administrative Order”) filed on June 3, 2020; it is hereby

ORDERED this 9th day of June, 2020 that the “Old” Catonsville District Court located at 900 Walker Avenue, Catonsville, MD 21228 shall be reopened for the progressive resumption of certain court operations effective on Monday, June 22, 2020 and it is further,

ORDERED that the matters authorized to be heard by the Court Commissioners at the “Old” Catonsville District Court, pursuant to Phases II, III, IV and V of the Amended Administrative Order, shall be heard at the “New” Catonsville District Court located at 1 Rolling Cross Road, Catonsville, MD 21228.
