

MONTGOMERY COUNTY DISTRICT COURT UPDATE FOR BAMC – June 30, 2020

This update provides everyone with updated docket grids reflecting the various case types and courtroom assignments being handled. Also attached are two docket grids that reflect the entirety of Phase III – July 20 through August 30. Despite many reviews and edits, it is possible that there are errors or typos that will require correction. However these charts generally show the case type and court sessions/times.

There are new case types introduced in various weeks and in both court locations. Our docket structures are different than the dockets pre-emergency. Civil matters are no longer limited to Wednesdays only. While summary ejectment matters remain on Wednesdays, other L&T matters have been moved to other days. It is our hope that this will allow the court to address more case types with greater efficiency and equity while social distancing requirements mandate limit the court's physical capacity.

A docket grid for Phase IV will follow in the near future. Thank you for your continued assistance and patience as we continue to work with limited staffing in both District Court locations.
