- emergency wrongful detainer actions
- trials for incarcerated defendants, other criminal charges alleging violent acts, alcoholrelated motor vehicle matters

- quarantine and isolation violations
- body attachments
- bail reconsiderations / matters involving locally incarcerated defendants
- preliminary hearings
- temporary restraining orders
- emergency breach of lease involving threats or injury to people or property
- rent escrow actions (provided local health depts. are able to provide inspection)
- tenant holding over actions
- warrants of restitution
