

**Harford Community Action Agency (HCAA)**

**COVID-19 Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)**

- **Who can apply for assistance?**
  - **Persons who are experiencing loss of income due to the COVID-19 Pandemic.**
  - **Individuals who have been unemployed for the 90 days prior to submitting application, households with the following incomes will be prioritized:**
    - Household size of:**
    - 1 - \$36,400**
    - 2 - \$41,600**
    - 3 - 46,800**
    - 4 - \$52,000**
    - 5 - \$56,200**
    - 6 - \$60,350**
    - 7 - \$64,500**
- **You can still apply for assistance through ERAP if you are denied by other programs.**
- **How much assistance will be received?**
  - **Assistance could be up to 12 months' rent. However, the amount of assistance will depend on the circumstances.**
  - **Assistance will be paid directly to the landlord and WILL NOT be given directly to the tenant.**
- **How to Apply:**
  - 1. Download application or fill it out online on the HCAA's website and submit to the HCAA**
  - 2. The Harford County District Court WILL NOT be collecting applications or assisting in the application process. We will make the application available.**
  - 3. For assistance in completing the application please contact the HCAA at 443-402-0326**

**Your Application must include:**

- a. Certification of loss of income due to COVID-19**
  - b. Last three pay stubs prior to job loss or decrease in employment**
  - c. Most recent bank statement(s)**
  - d. Verification of benefits within the last 30 days**
  - e. W-2/1099 tax forms for 2019 and/or self-certification**
  - f. Most recent utility bill(s)**
  - g. Eviction Notice or correspondence from landlord indicating amount of rent owed, and;**
  - h. Fully executed lease/agreement and addendums**
