PURPOSE

Provide Marylanders with an opportunity to interact with members of the Judiciary in a community-based and ongoing-dialogue to:

- Increase community understanding of the courts and its services
- Strengthen public confidence in the judicial system
- Enable the Judiciary to gain a better understanding of how it is viewed by the community

THREE GOALS

- Organize community forums in each jurisdiction that are facilitated by a third-party neutral – "How Maryland Courts Can Work Best for Everyone: A Conversation Between Court and Community Leaders"
 - Create opportunities to listen to community members
 - Provide information about court programs and services in each jurisdiction
 - Gain an understanding of community members' needs and ways the courts can provide better service
 - Created five regional workgroups to facilitate forums
 - Central Maryland
 - Southern Maryland
 - Suburban Maryland
 - Upper Shore/Harford County
 - Western Maryland
 - Forums expected to begin Summer 2021
- Develop advisory boards in each jurisdiction with rotating membership to ensure a diversity of voices
- Establish a community advisory officer in each jurisdiction to serve as the community liaison/point of contact for the community
