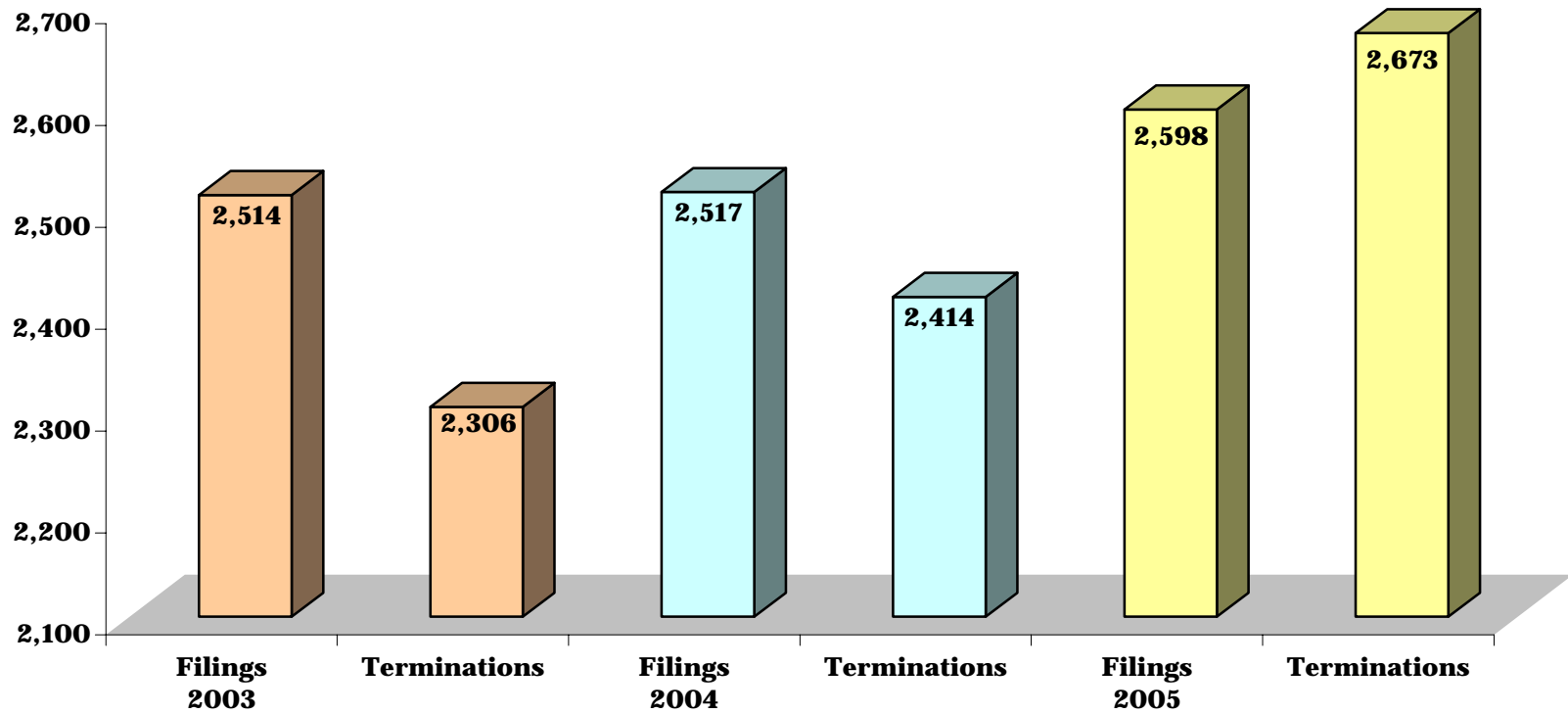

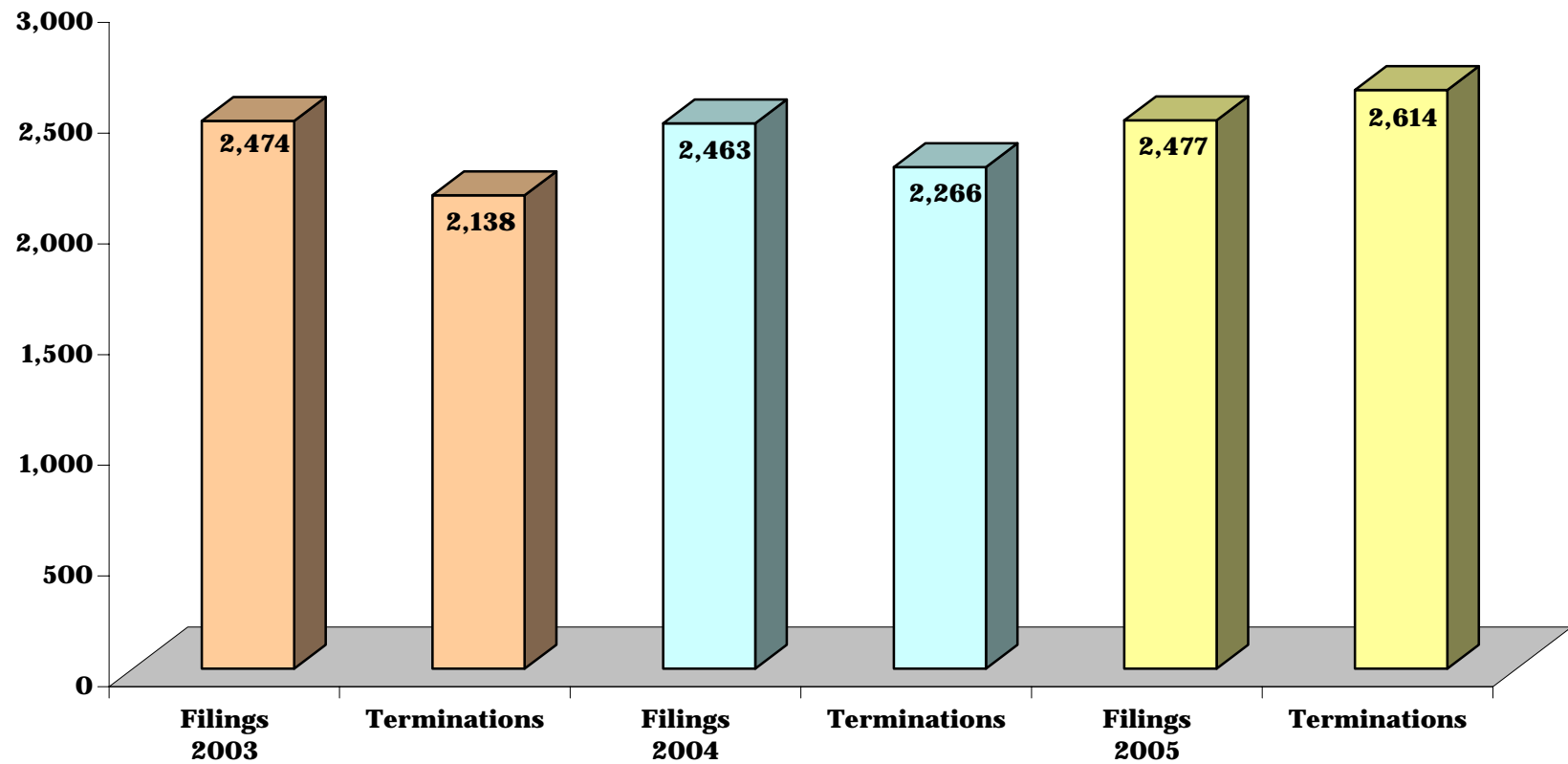

**3 Year Comparative Data: Fiscal Years 2003 - 2005**

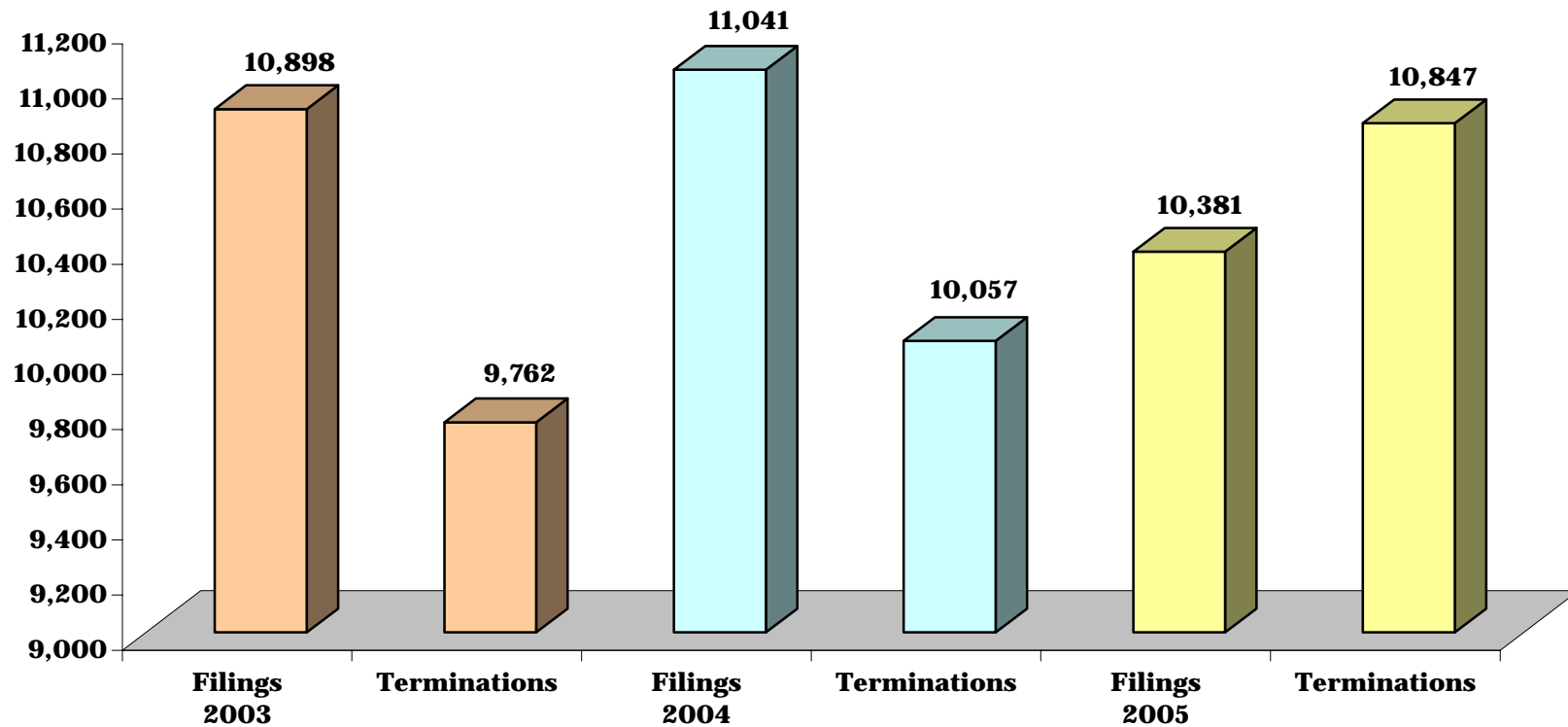

**3 Year Comparative Data: Fiscal Years 2003 - 2005**

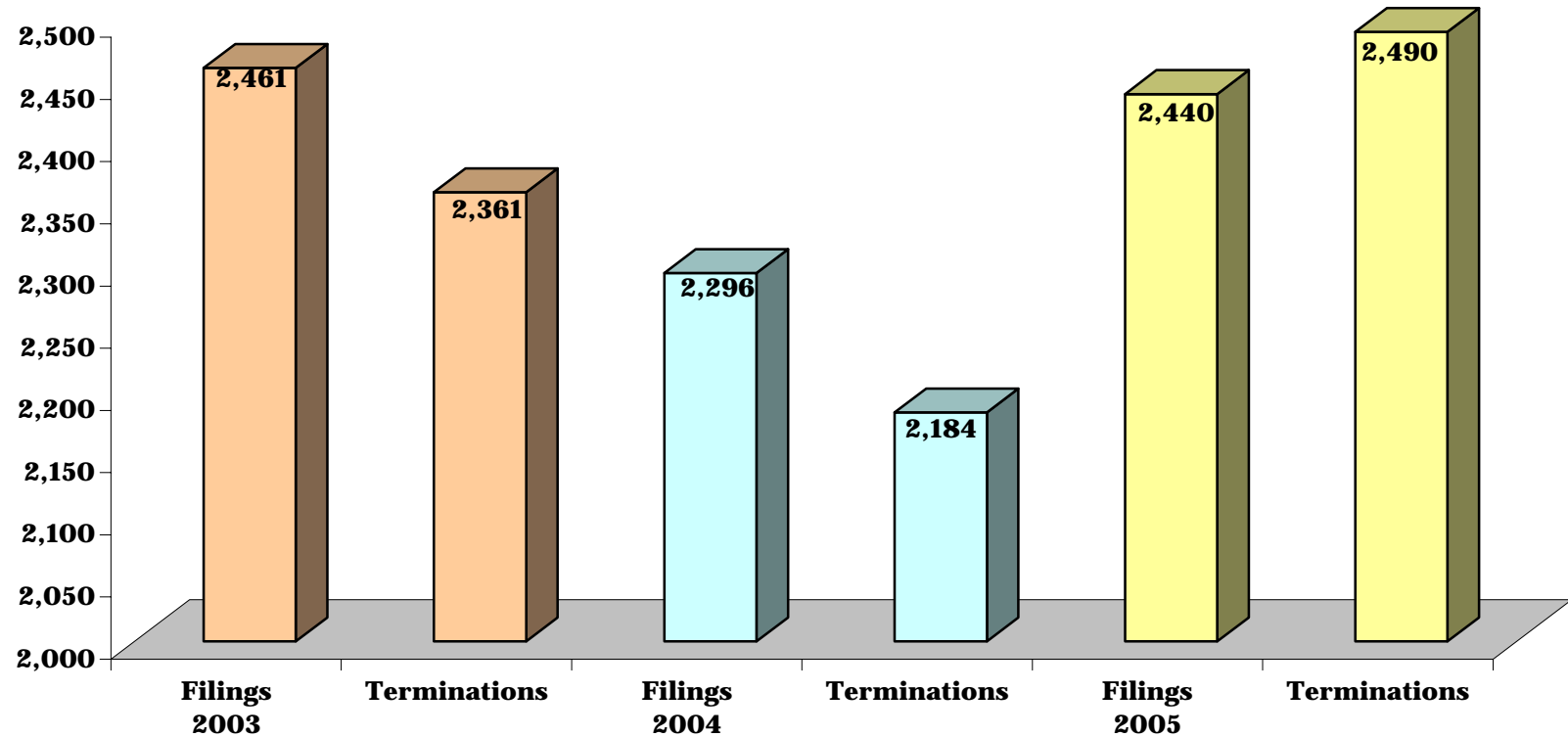


**CHART CC-5.4

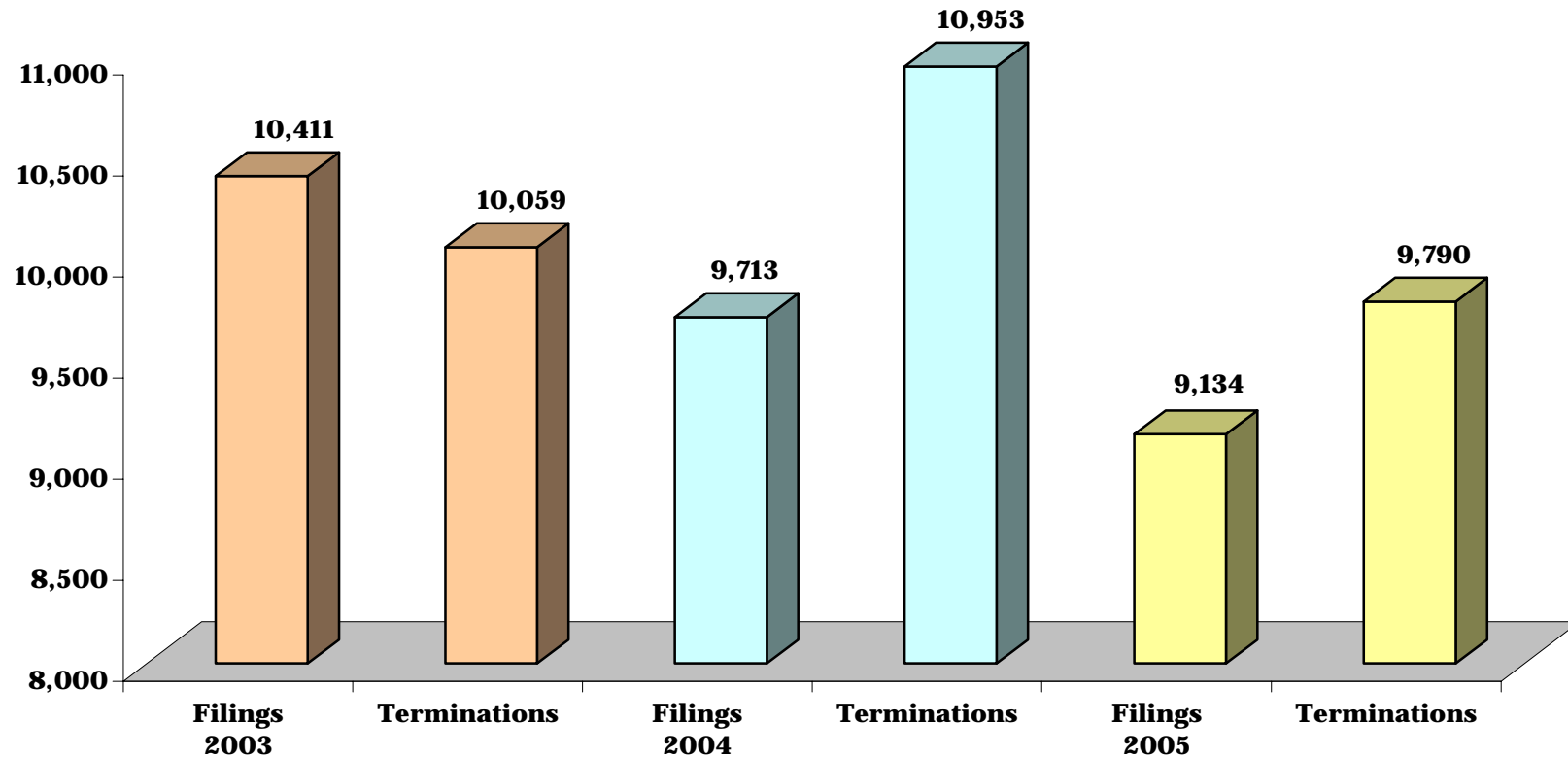


**CHART CC-5.5

**3 Year Comparative Data: Fiscal Years 2003 - 2005**

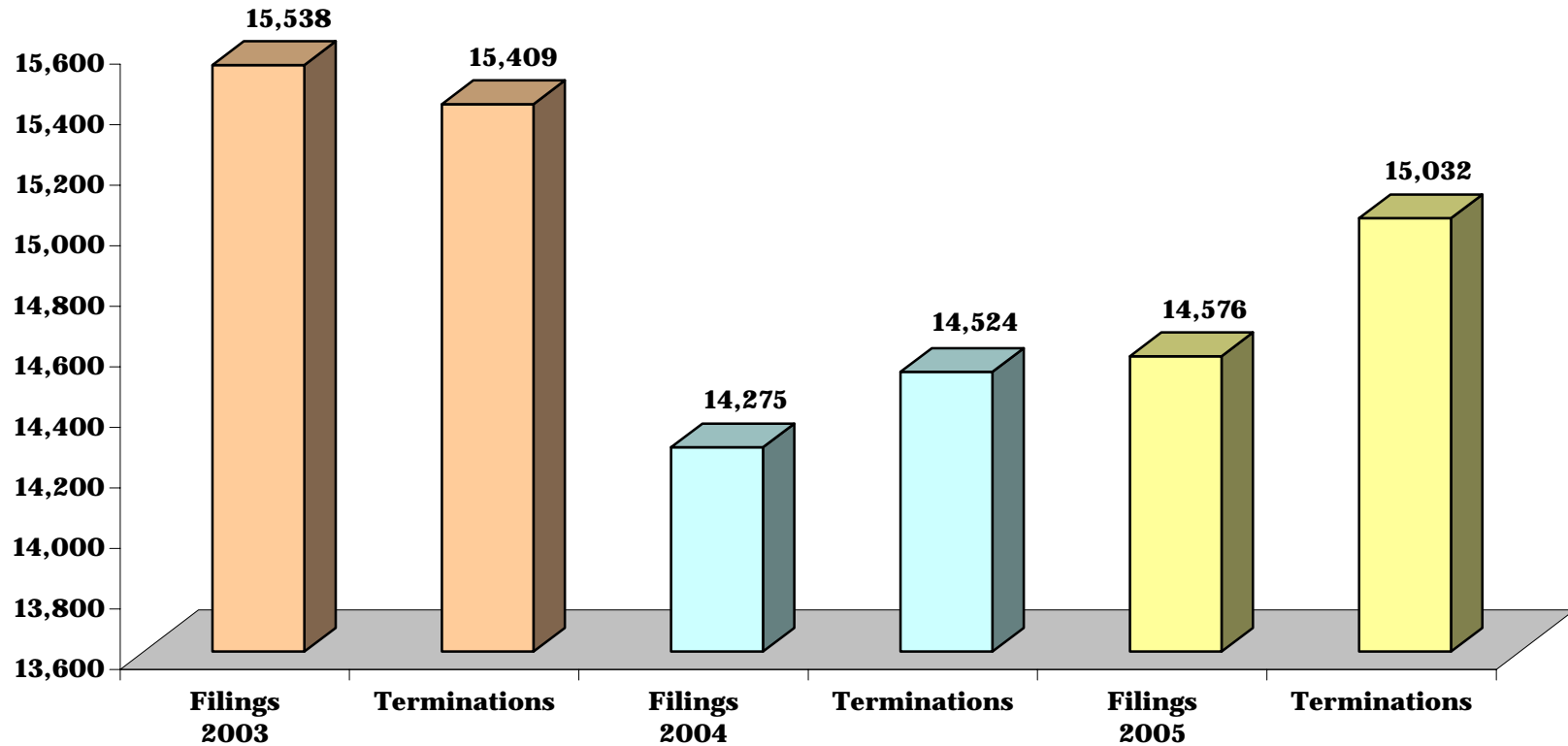

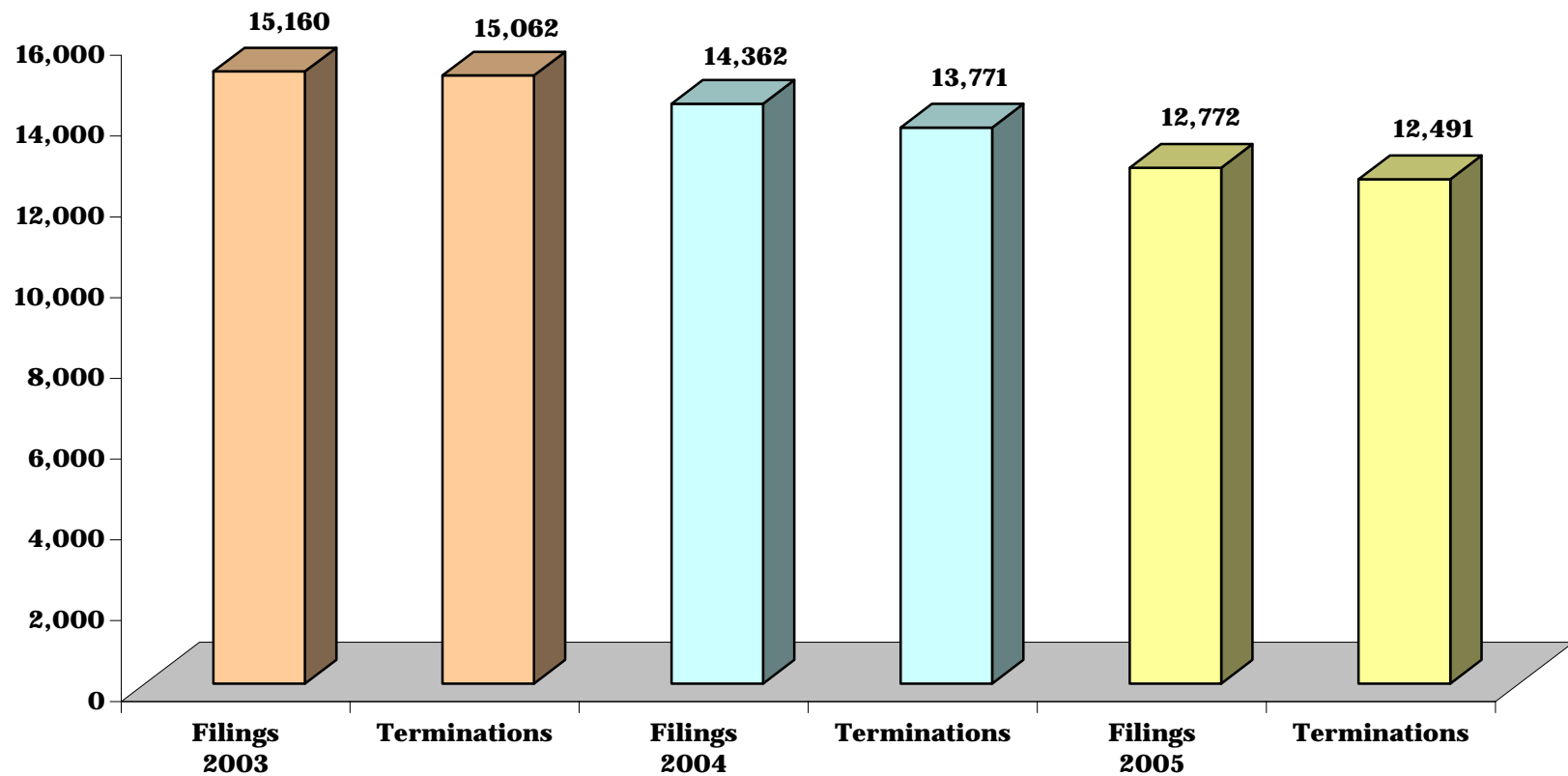

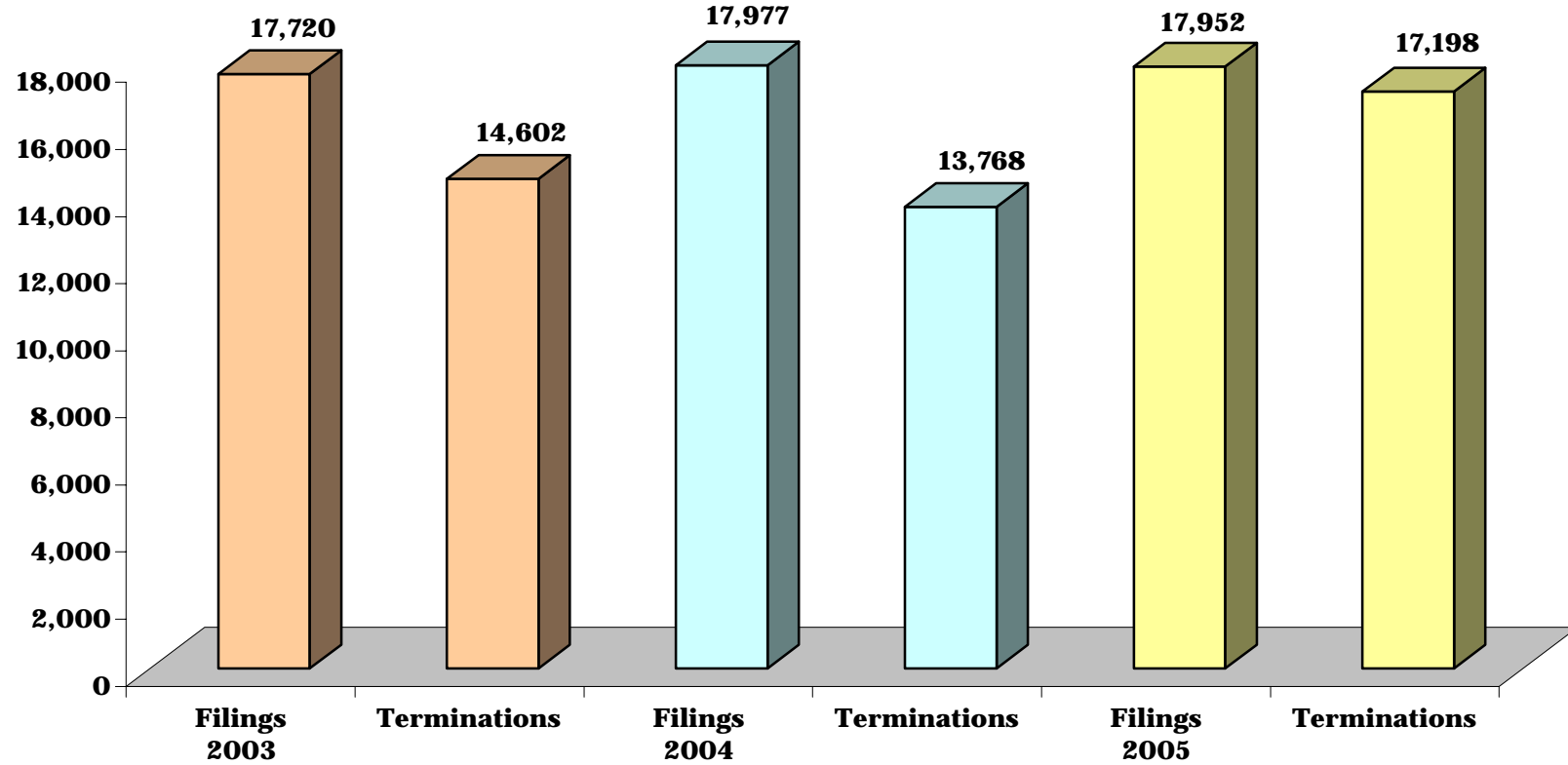

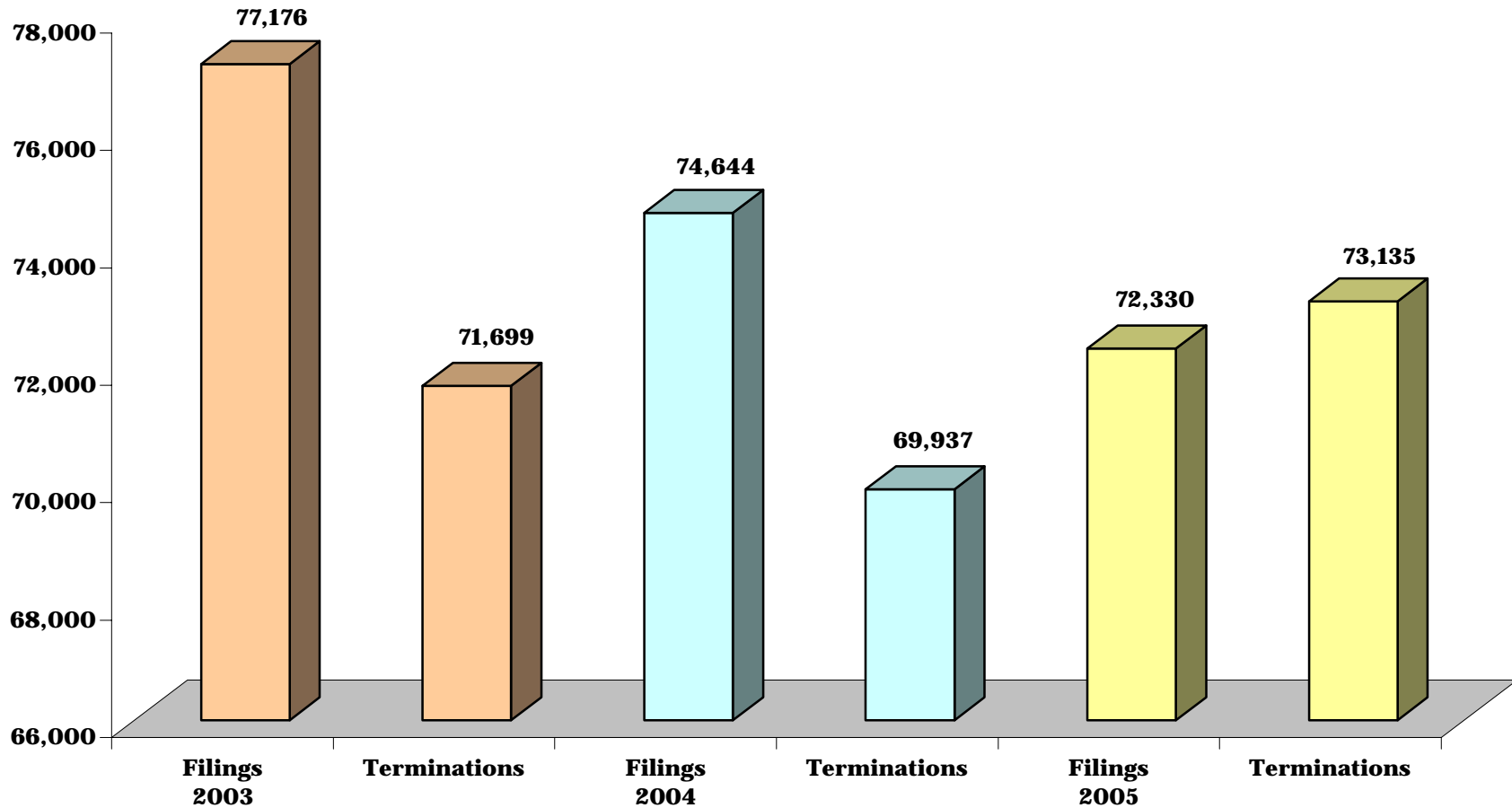

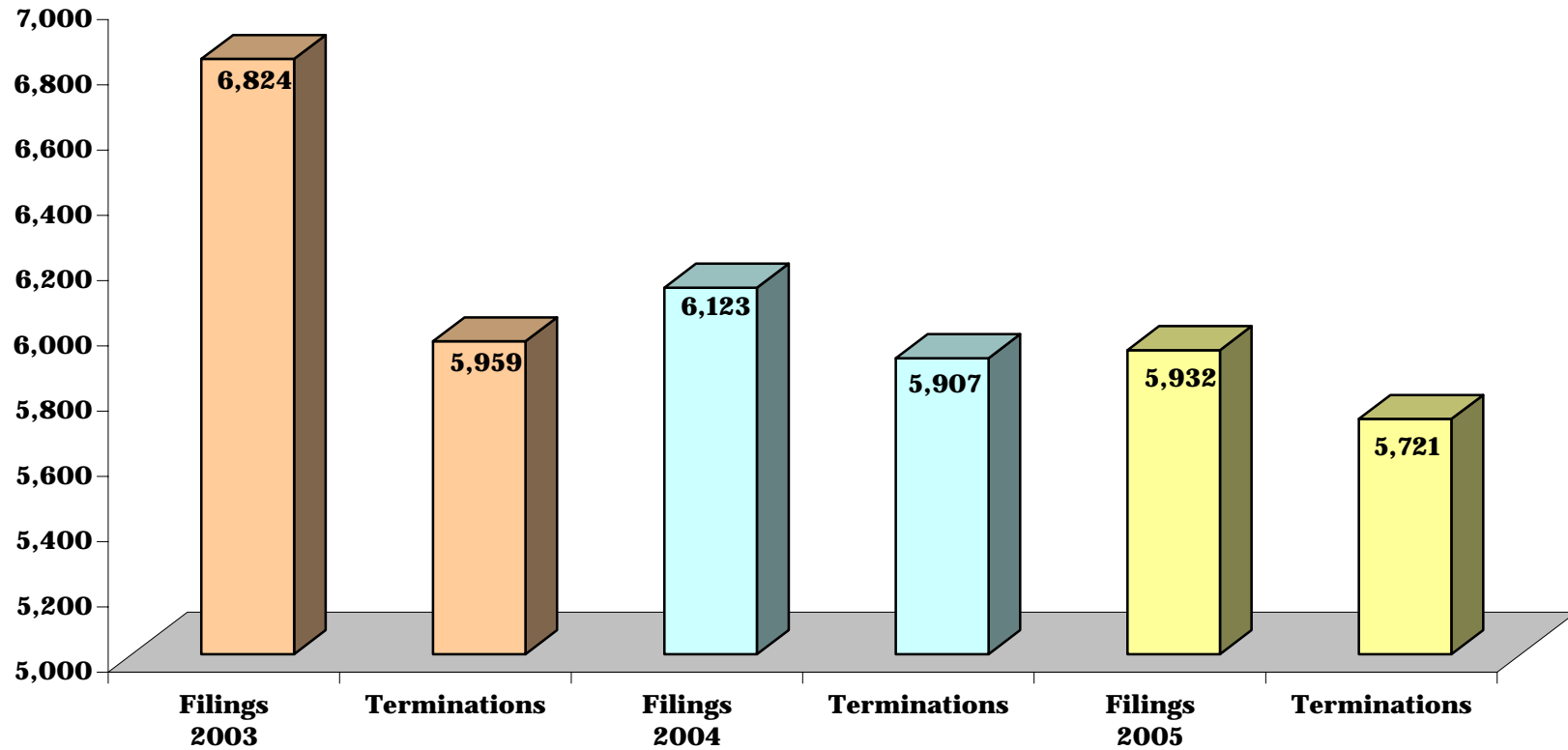

Dorchester, Somerset, Wicomico and Worcester Counties**

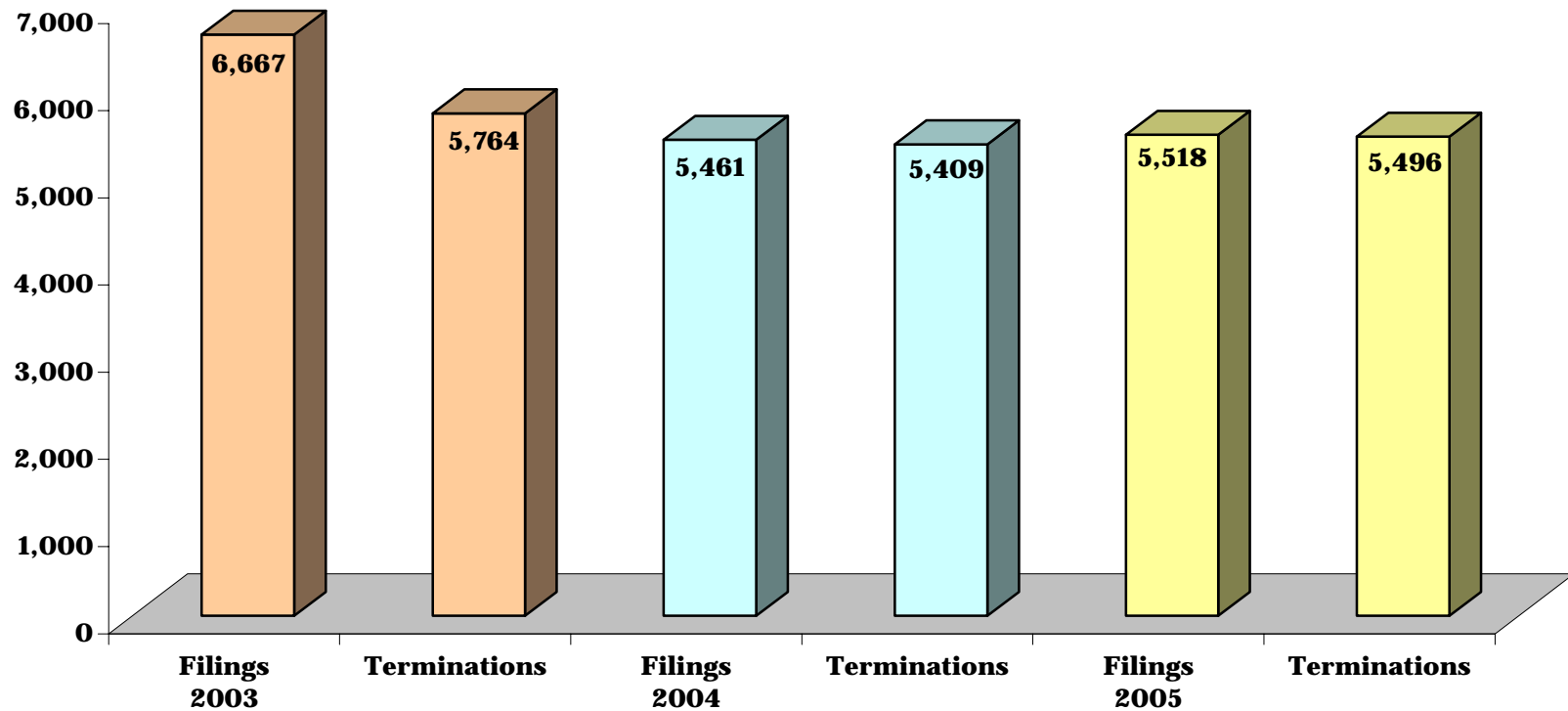

Caroline, Cecil, Kent, Queen Anne's and Talbot Counties**

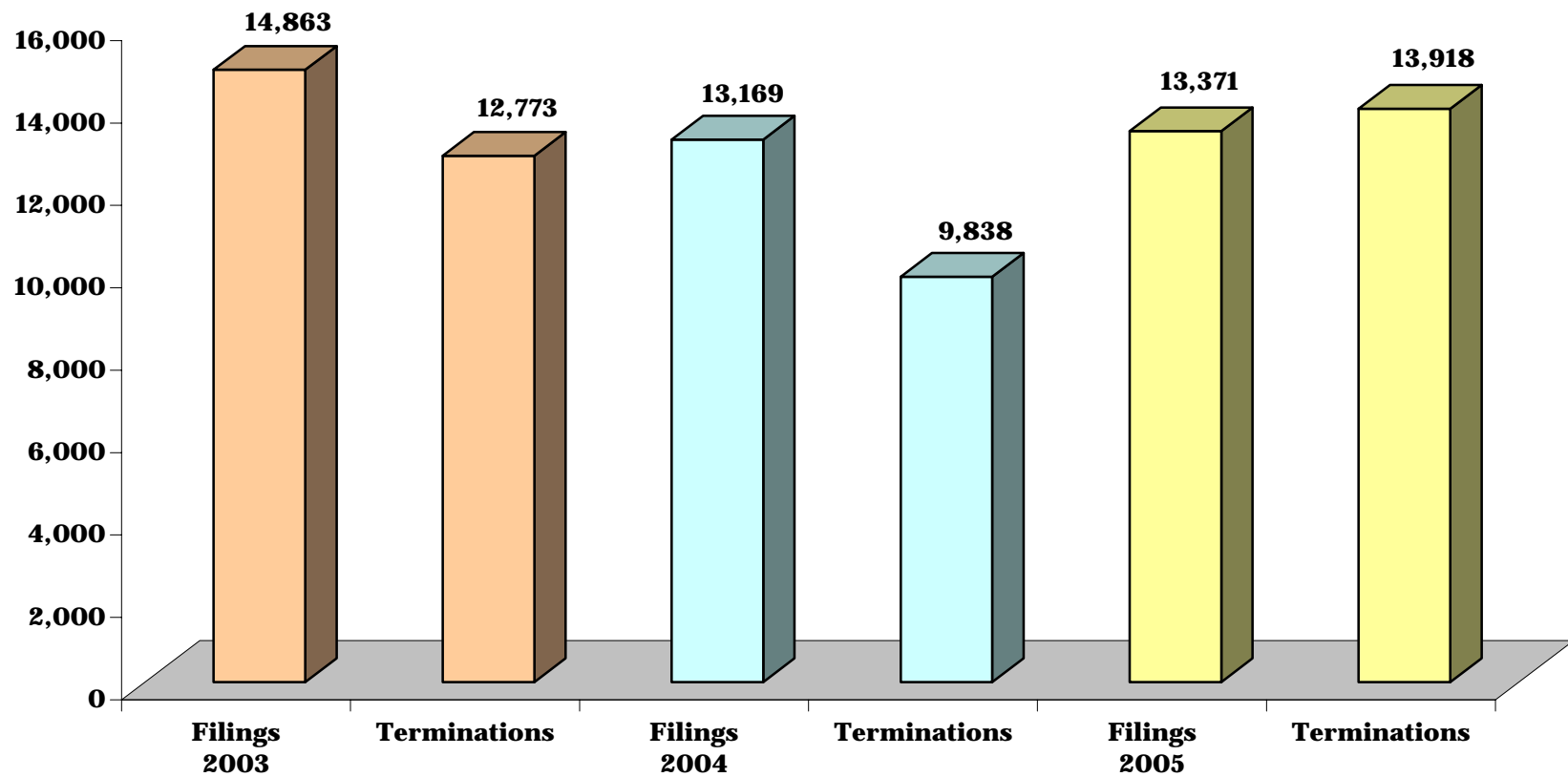

3 Year Comparative Data: Fiscal Years 2003 - 2005**

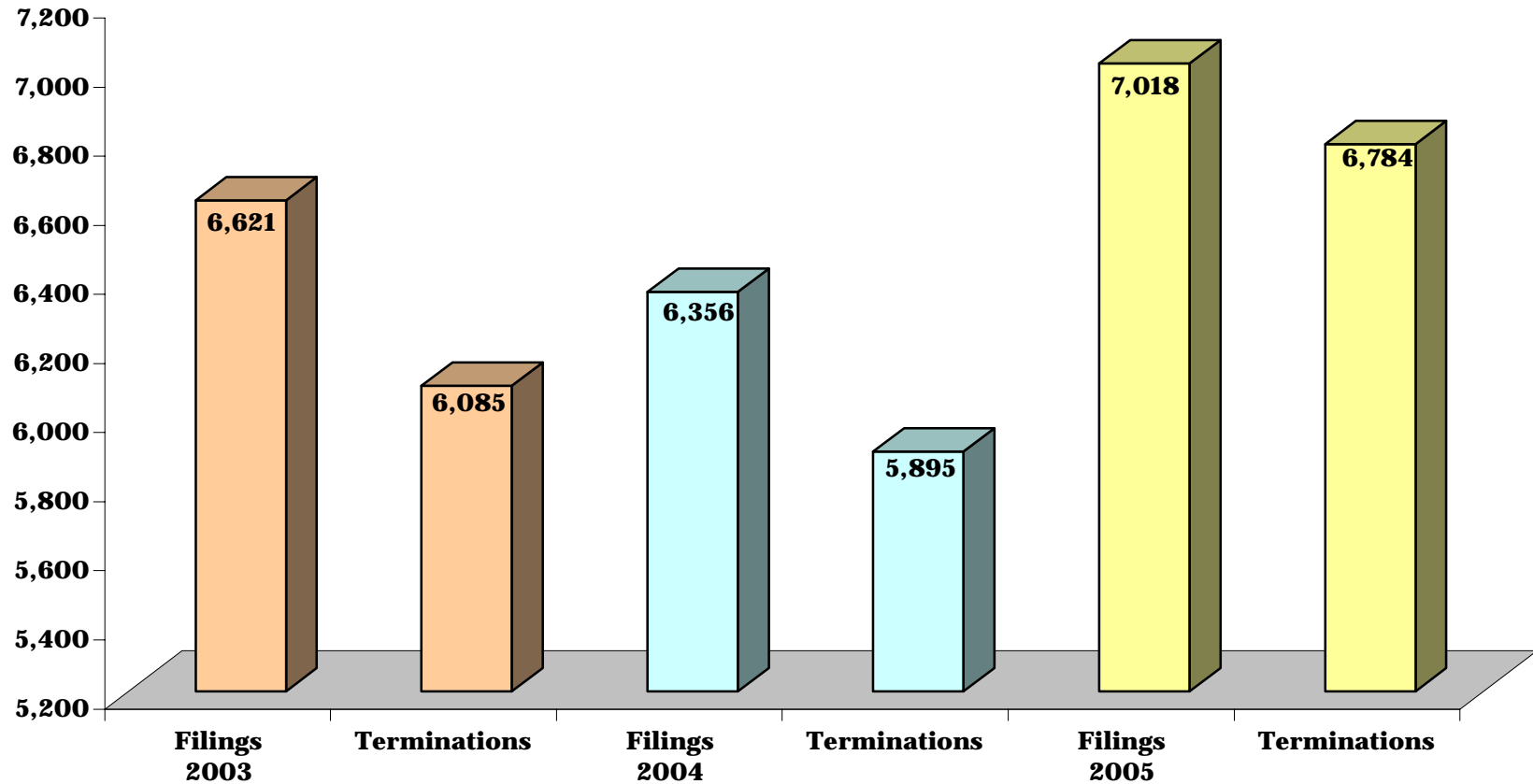

Allegany, Garrett and Washington Counties**

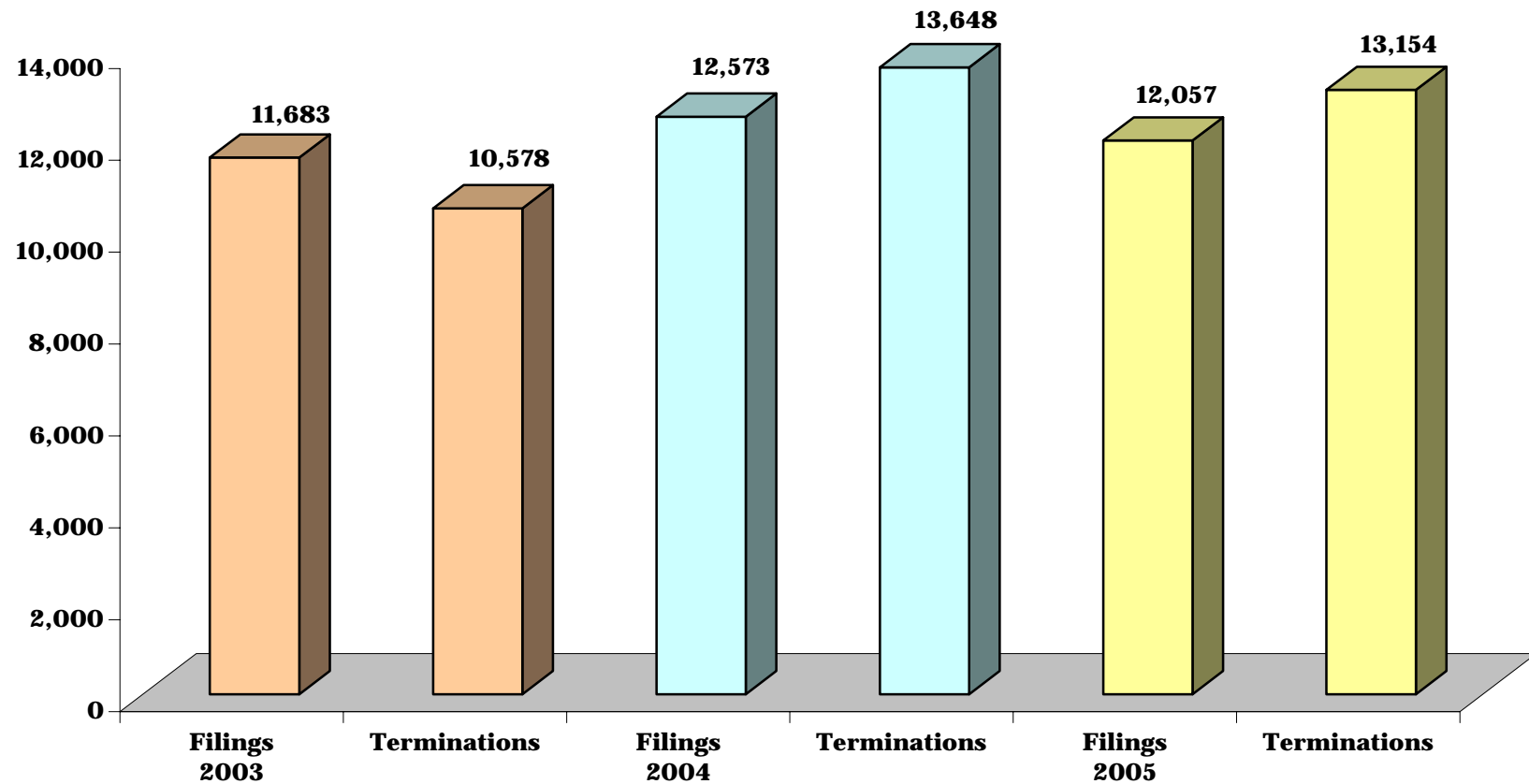

Anne Arundel, Carroll and Howard Counties**

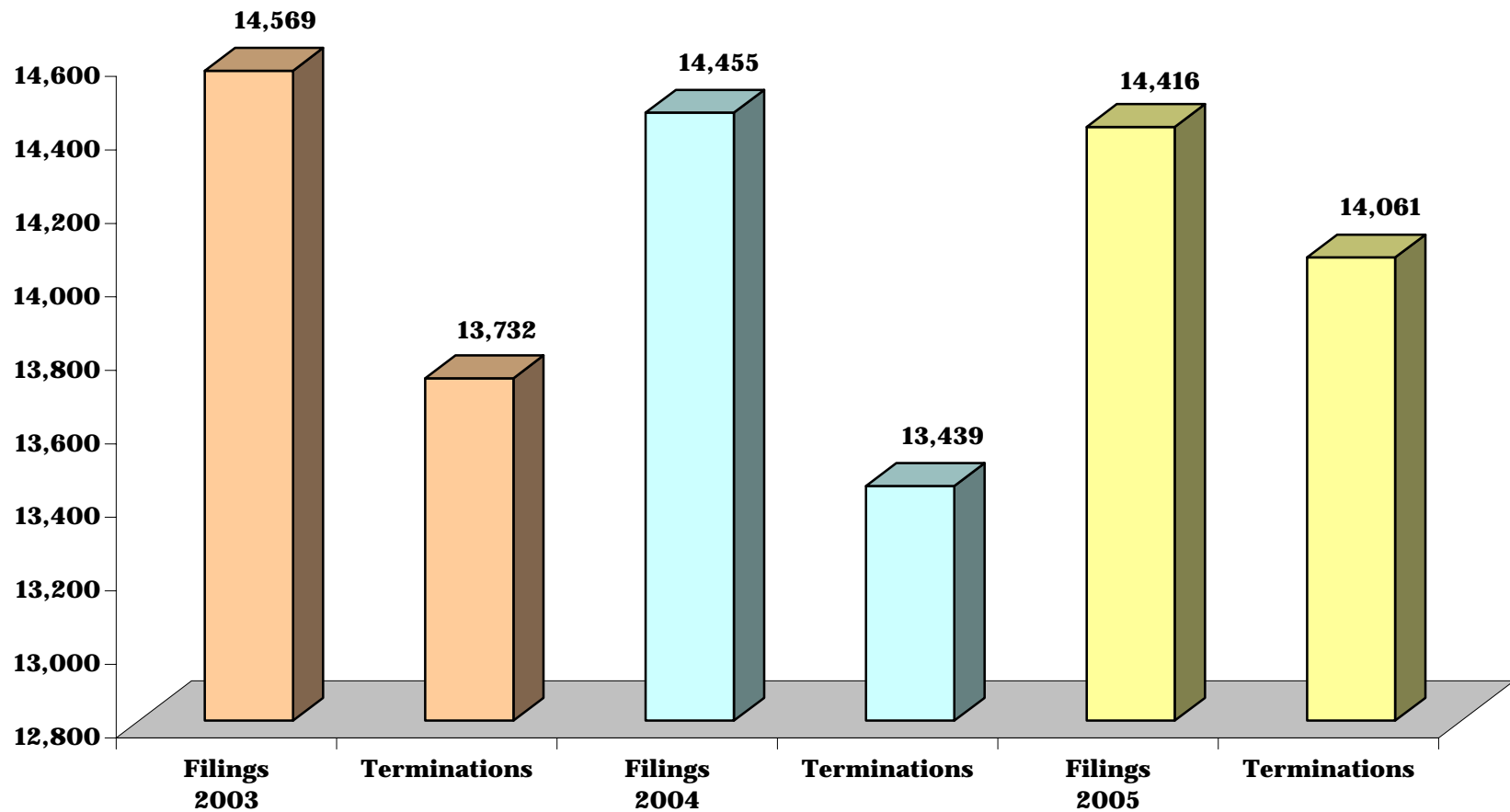

Frederick and Montgomery Counties**

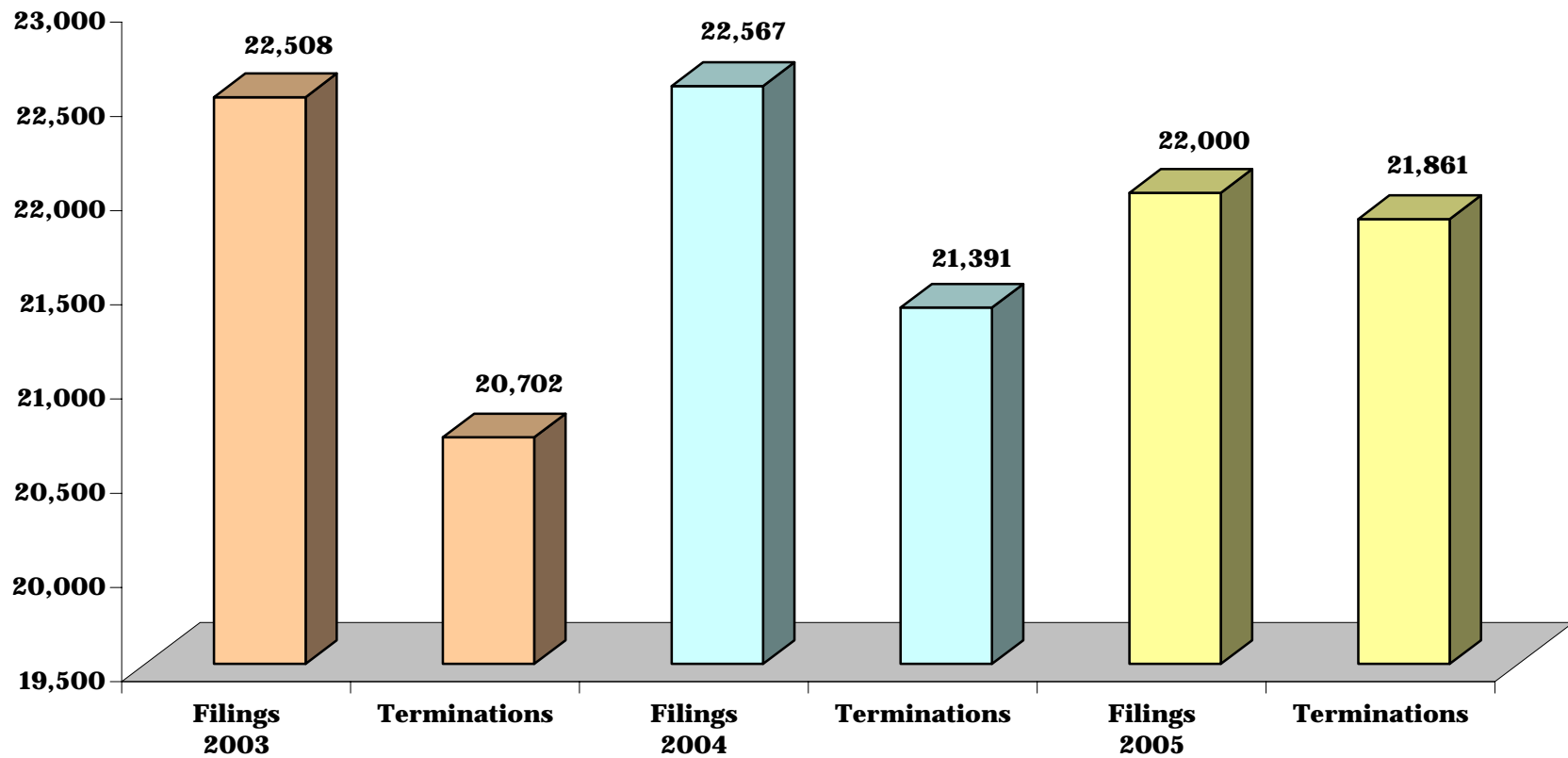

Calvert, Charles, Prince George's and St. Mary's Counties**

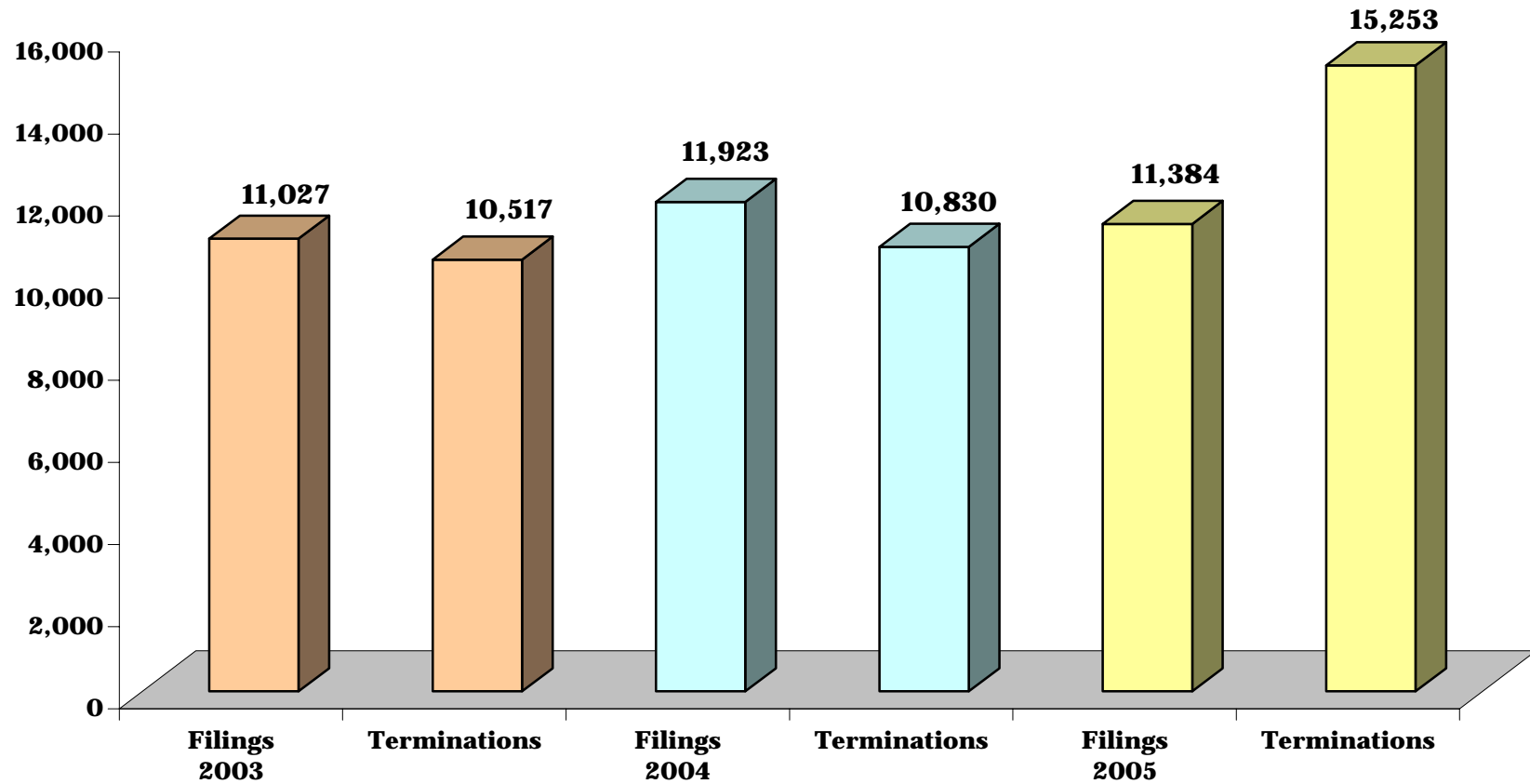

CIRCUIT COURT**

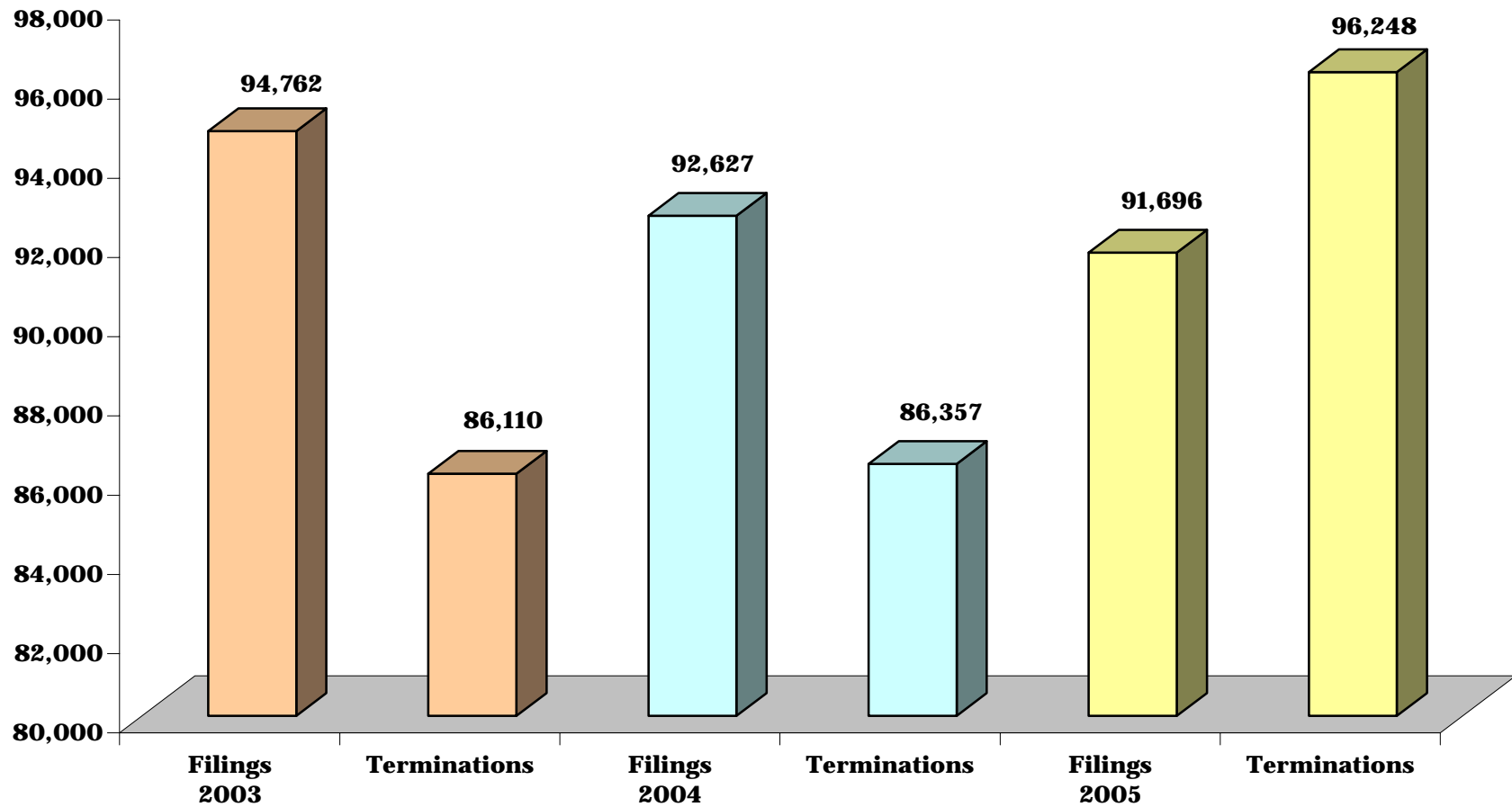

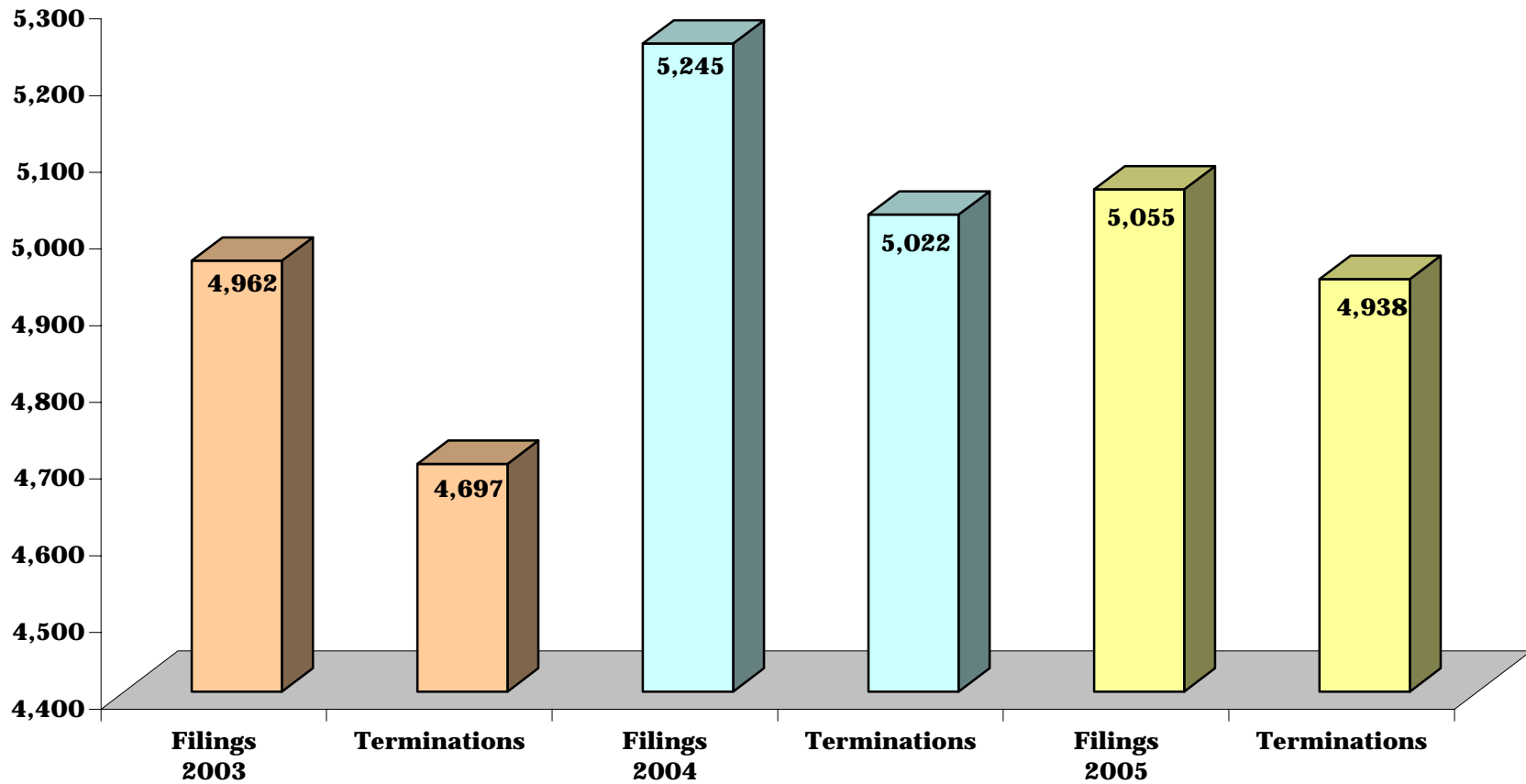

Dorchester, Somerset, Wicomico and Worcester Counties**

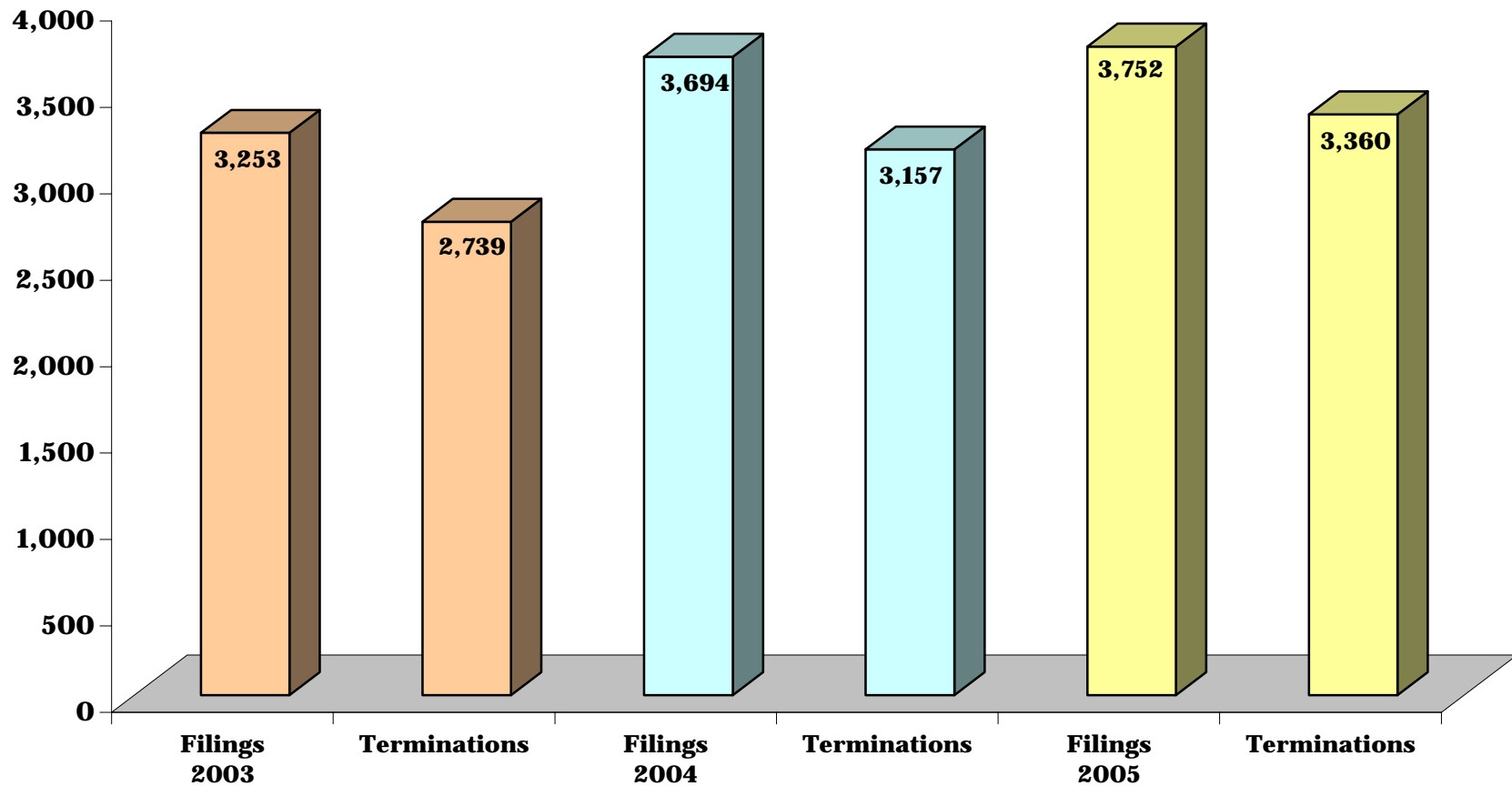

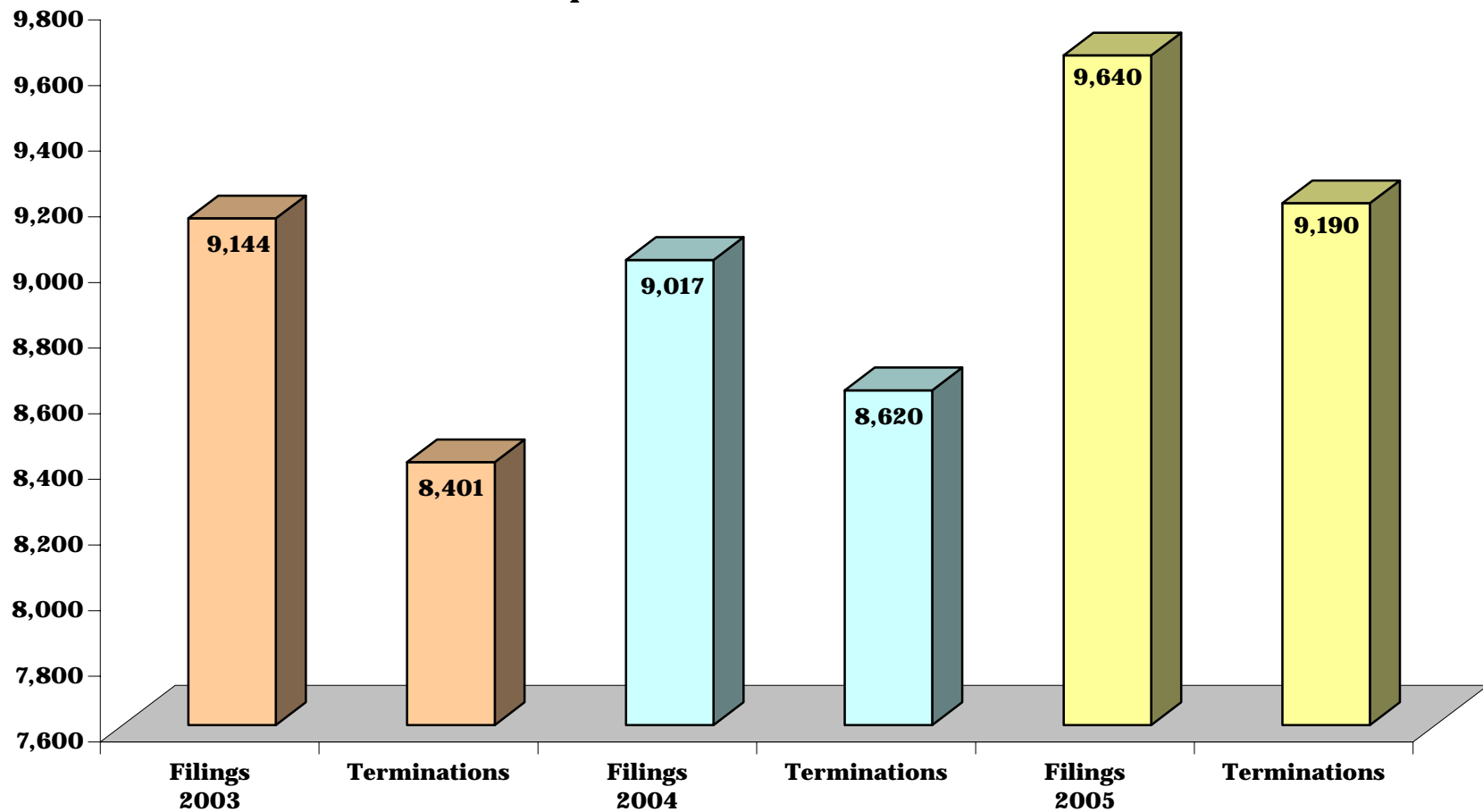

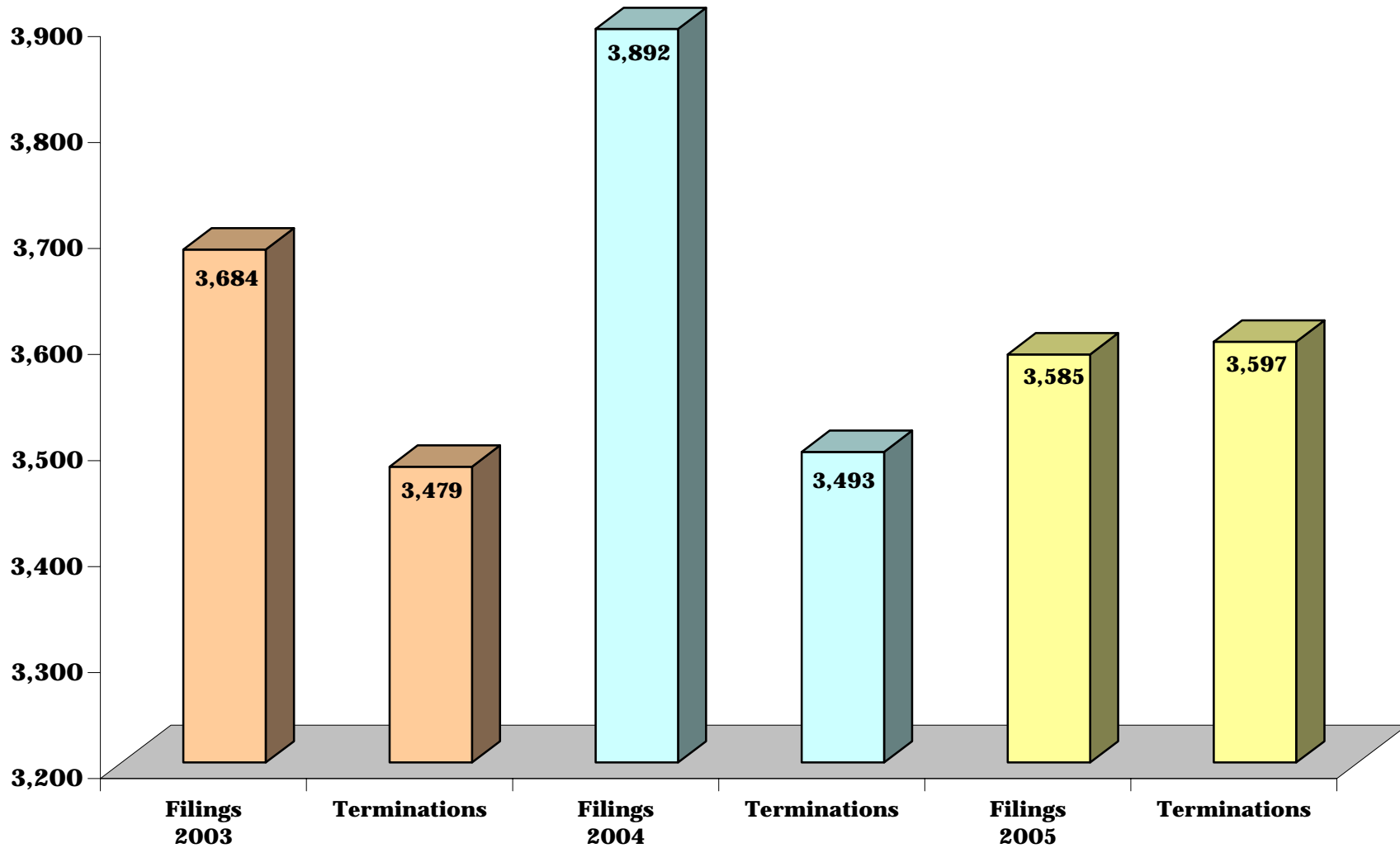

Allegany, Garrett and Washington Counties**

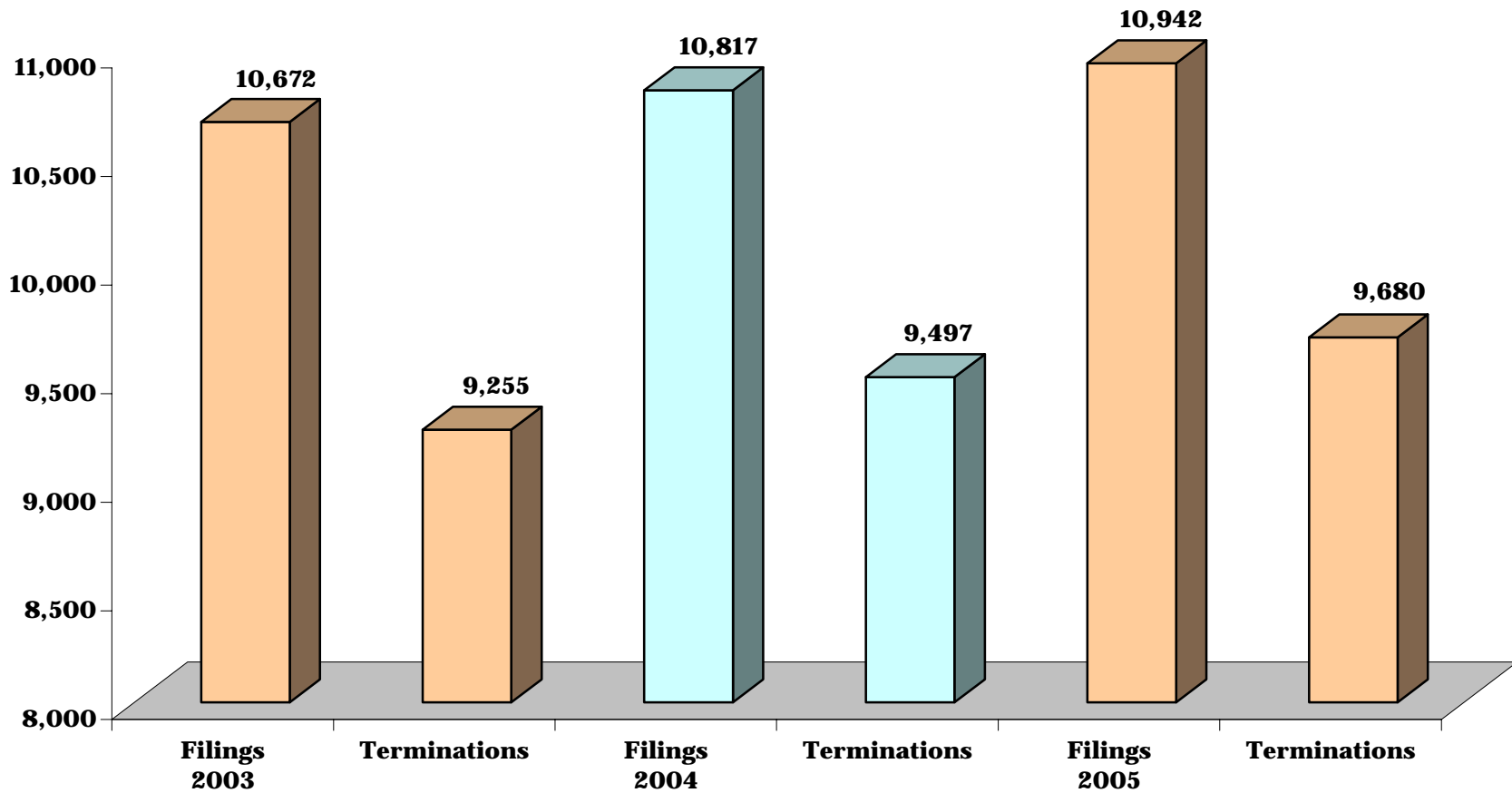

Anne Arundel, Carroll and Howard Counties**

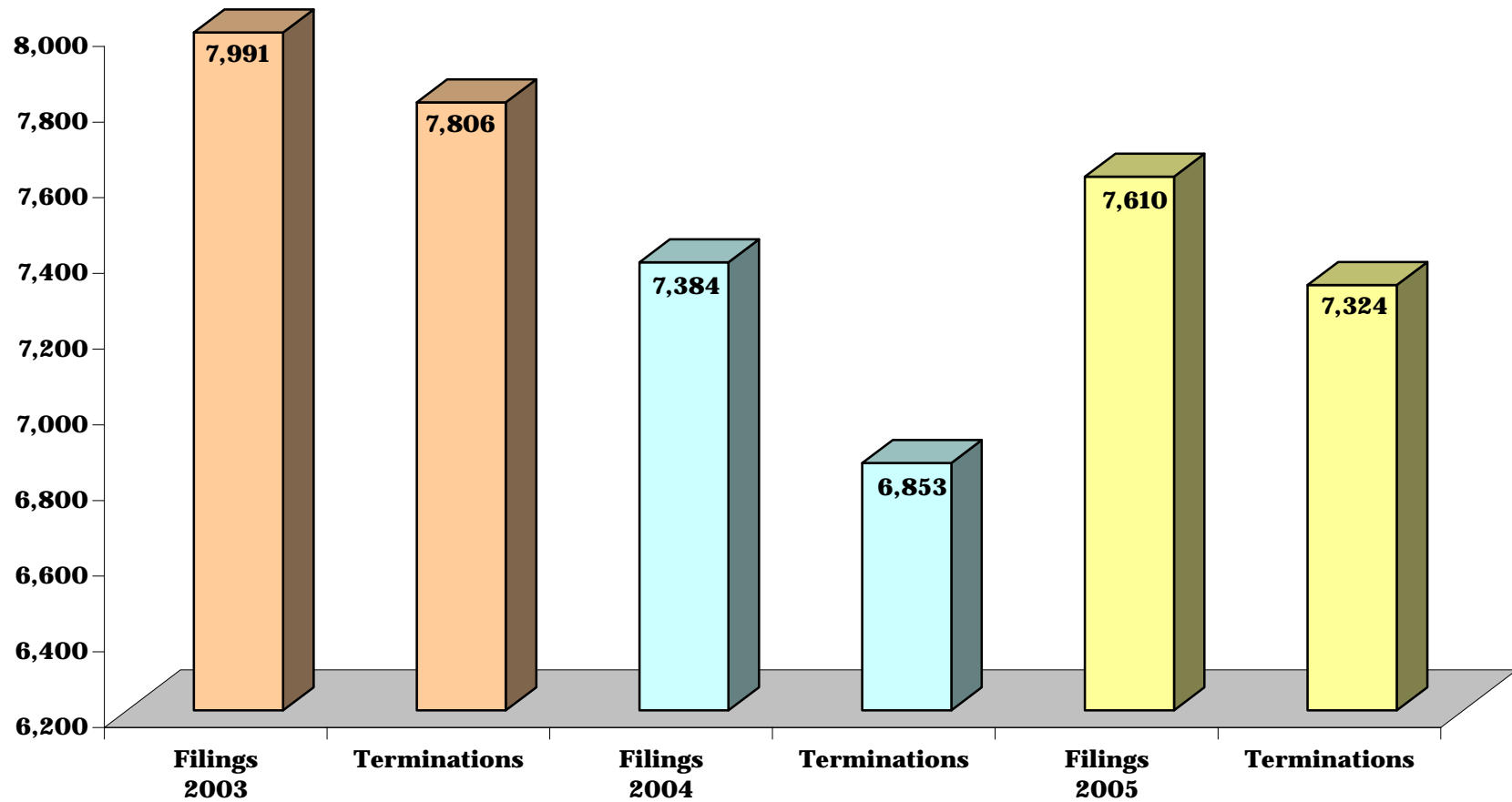

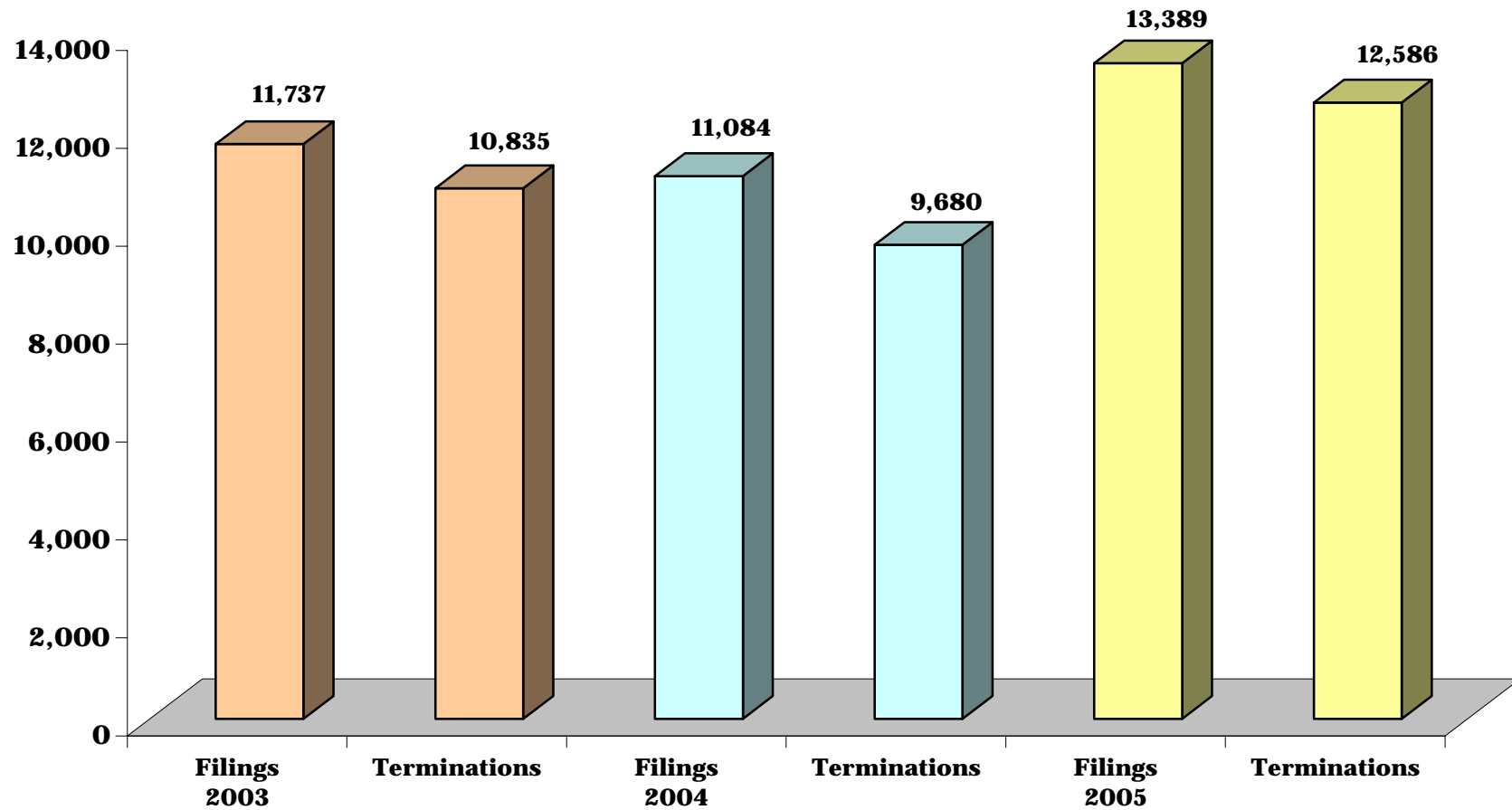

Calvert, Charles, Prince George's and St. Mary's Counties**

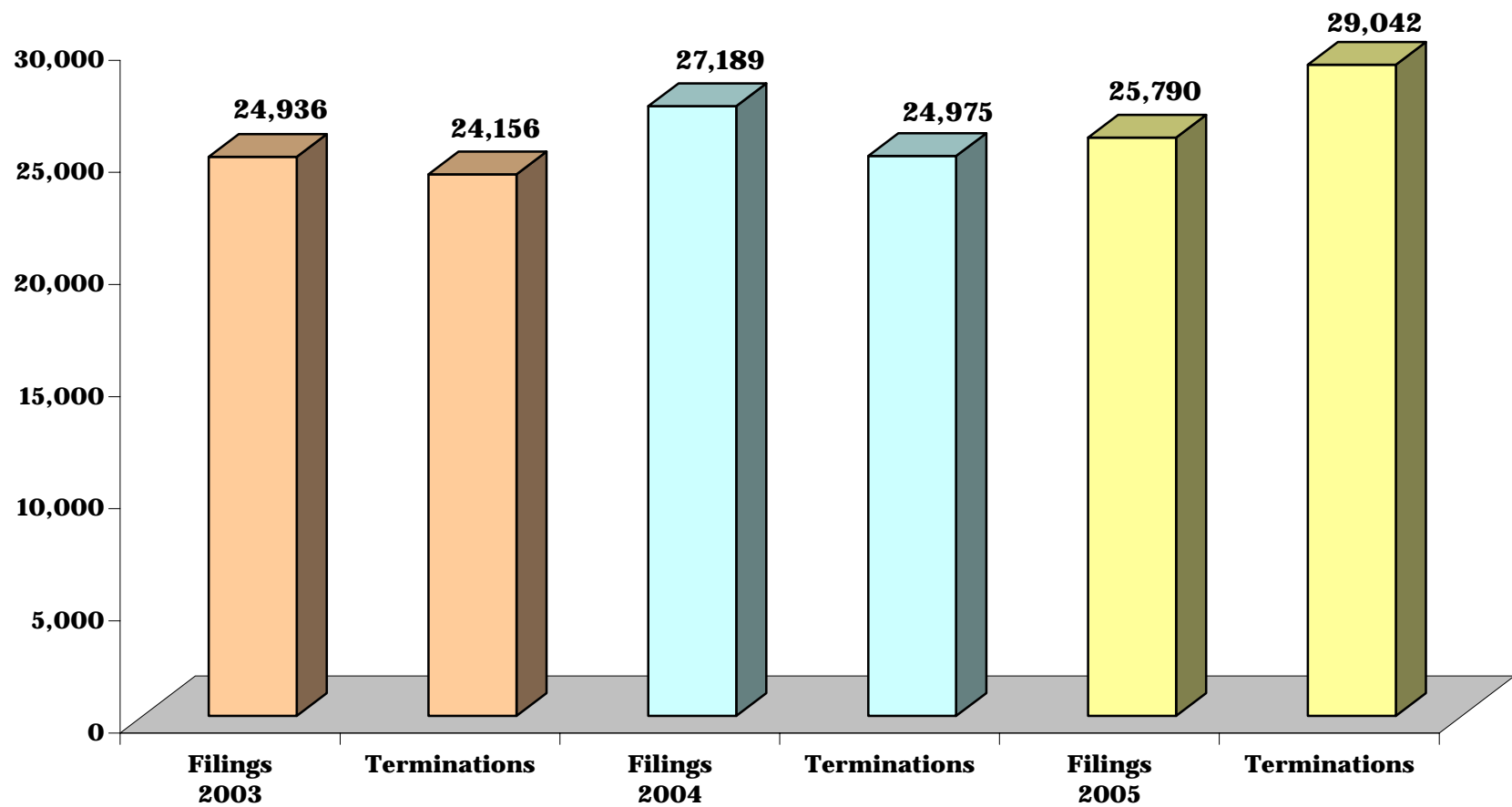

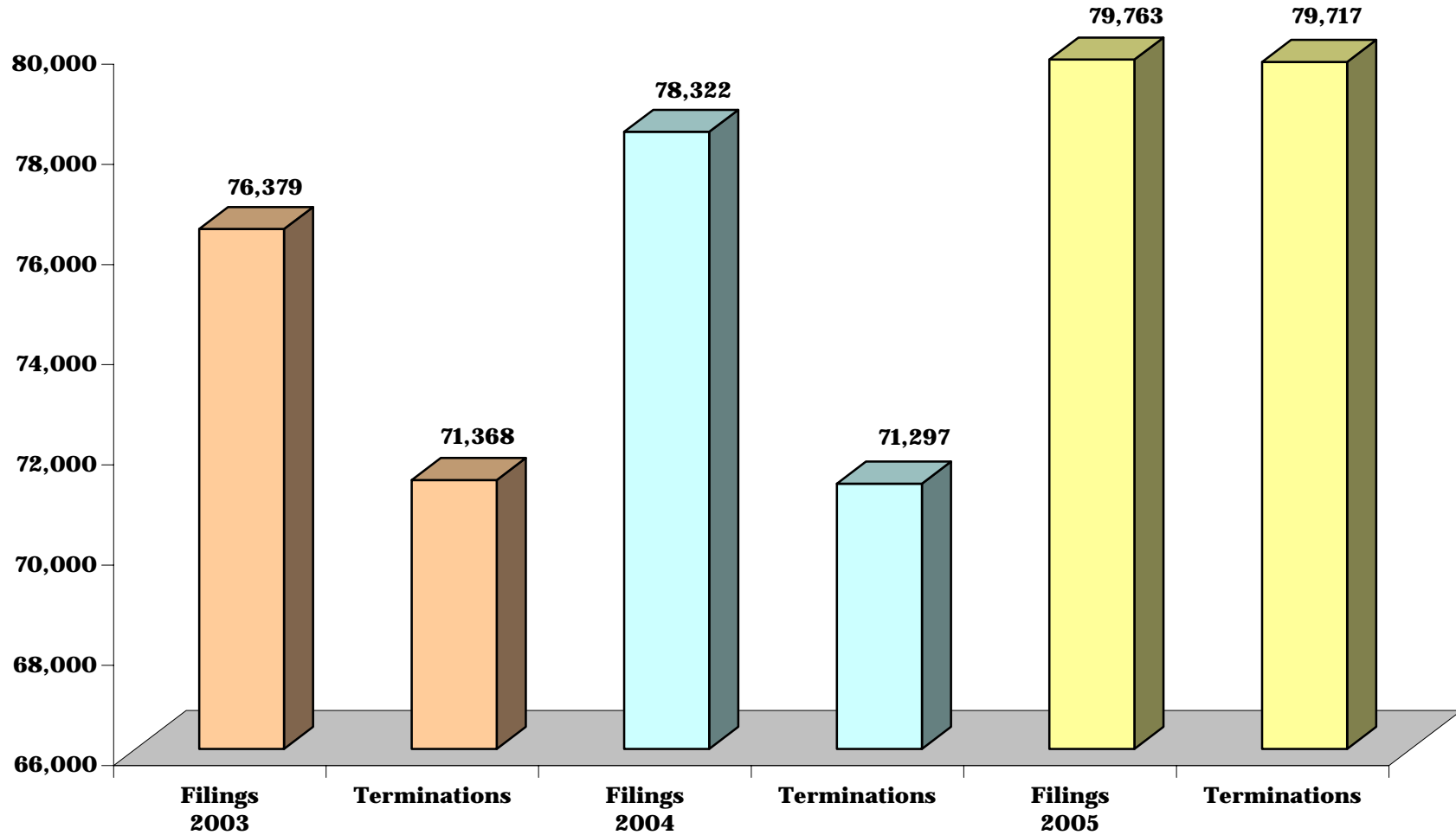

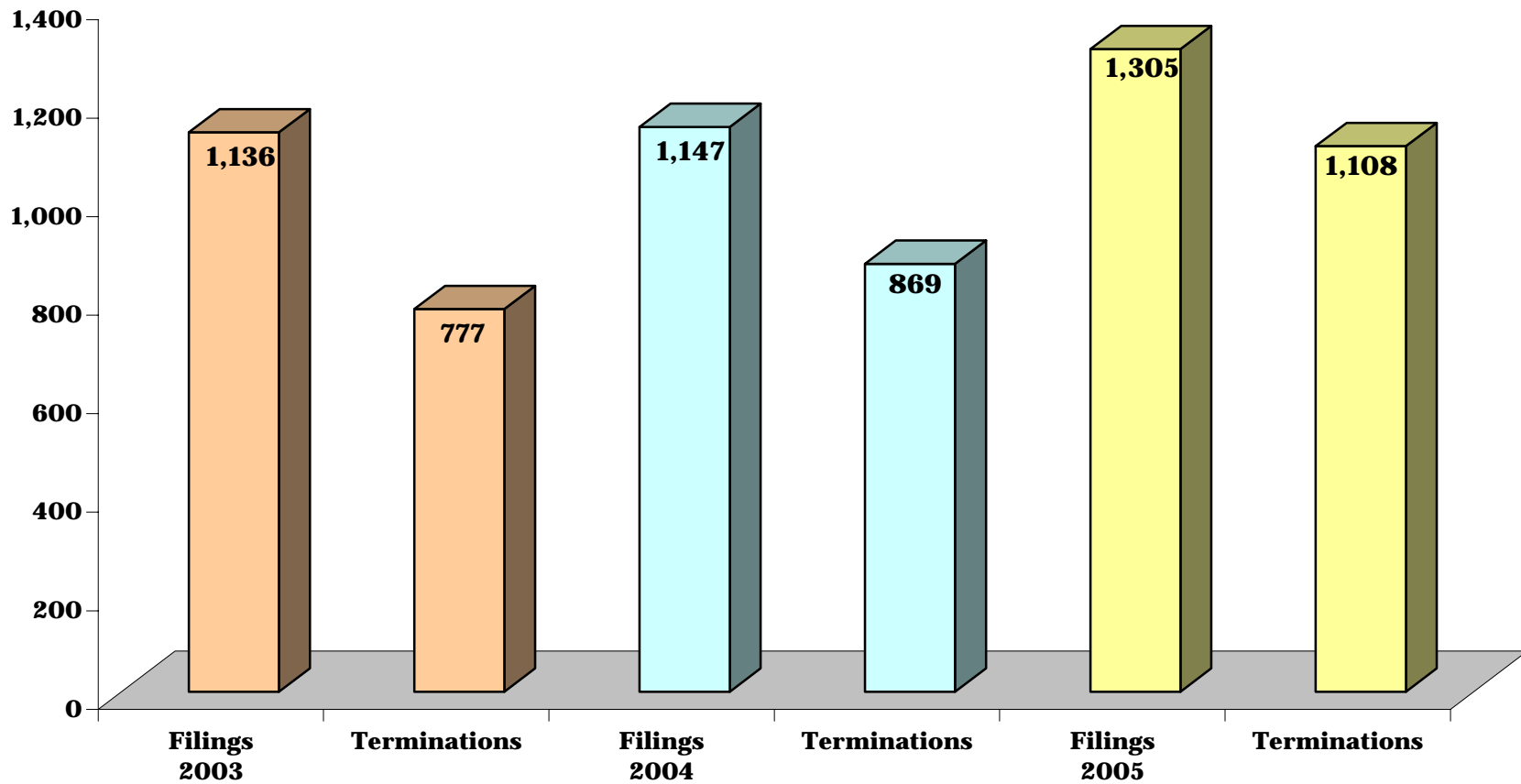

Caroline, Cecil, Kent, Queen Anne's and Talbot's Counties**

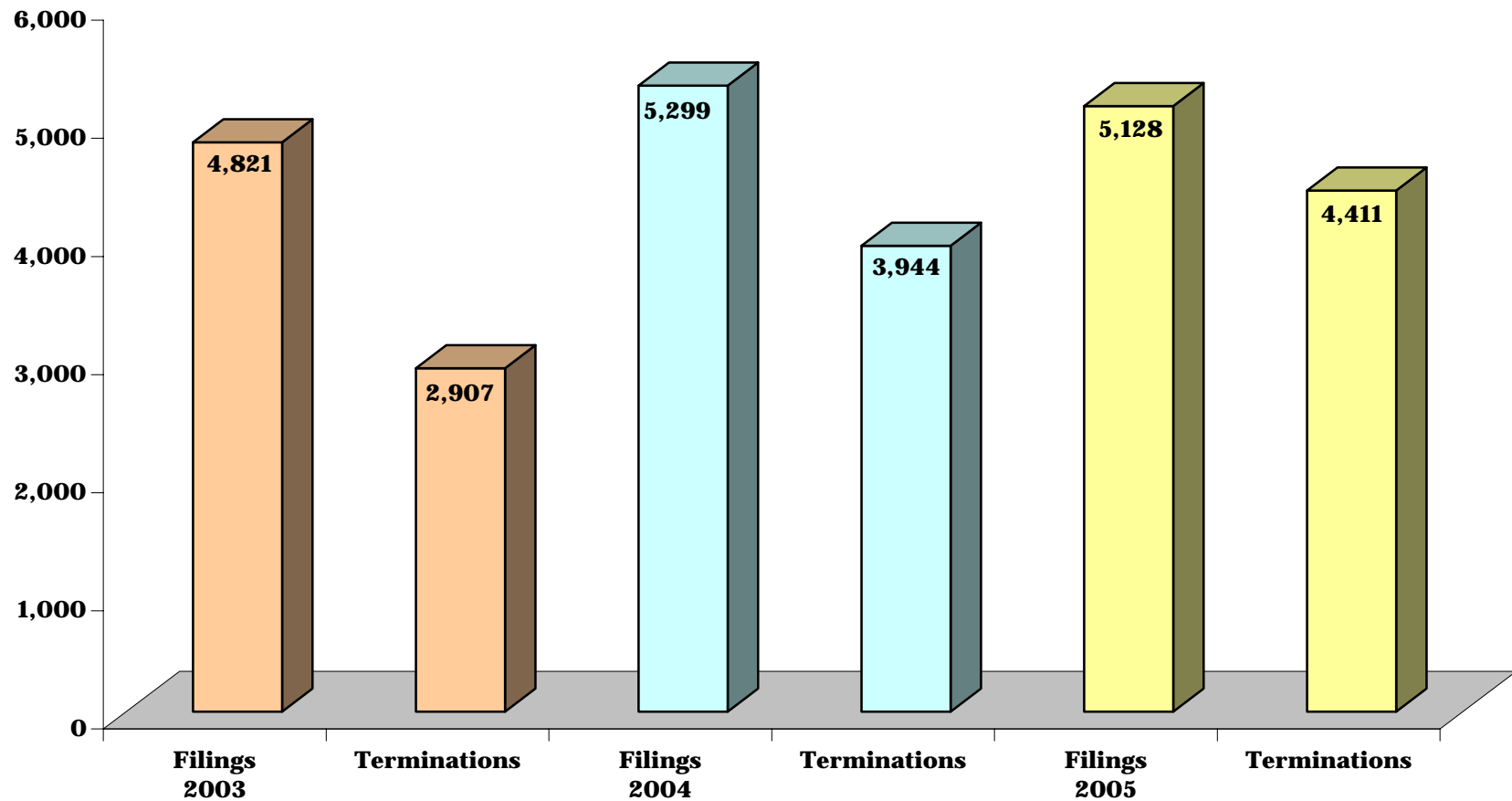

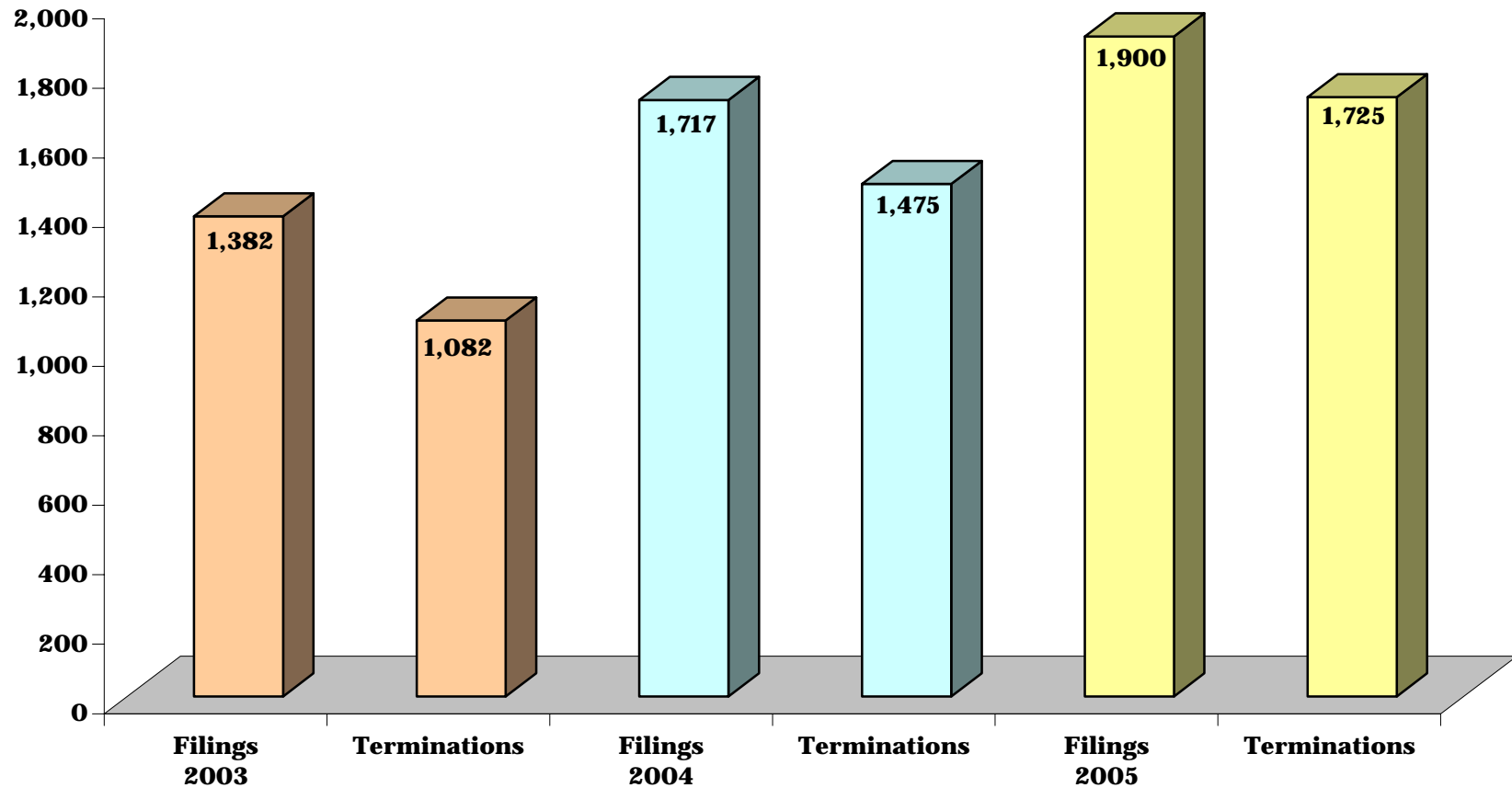

Allegheny, Garrett and Washington Counties**

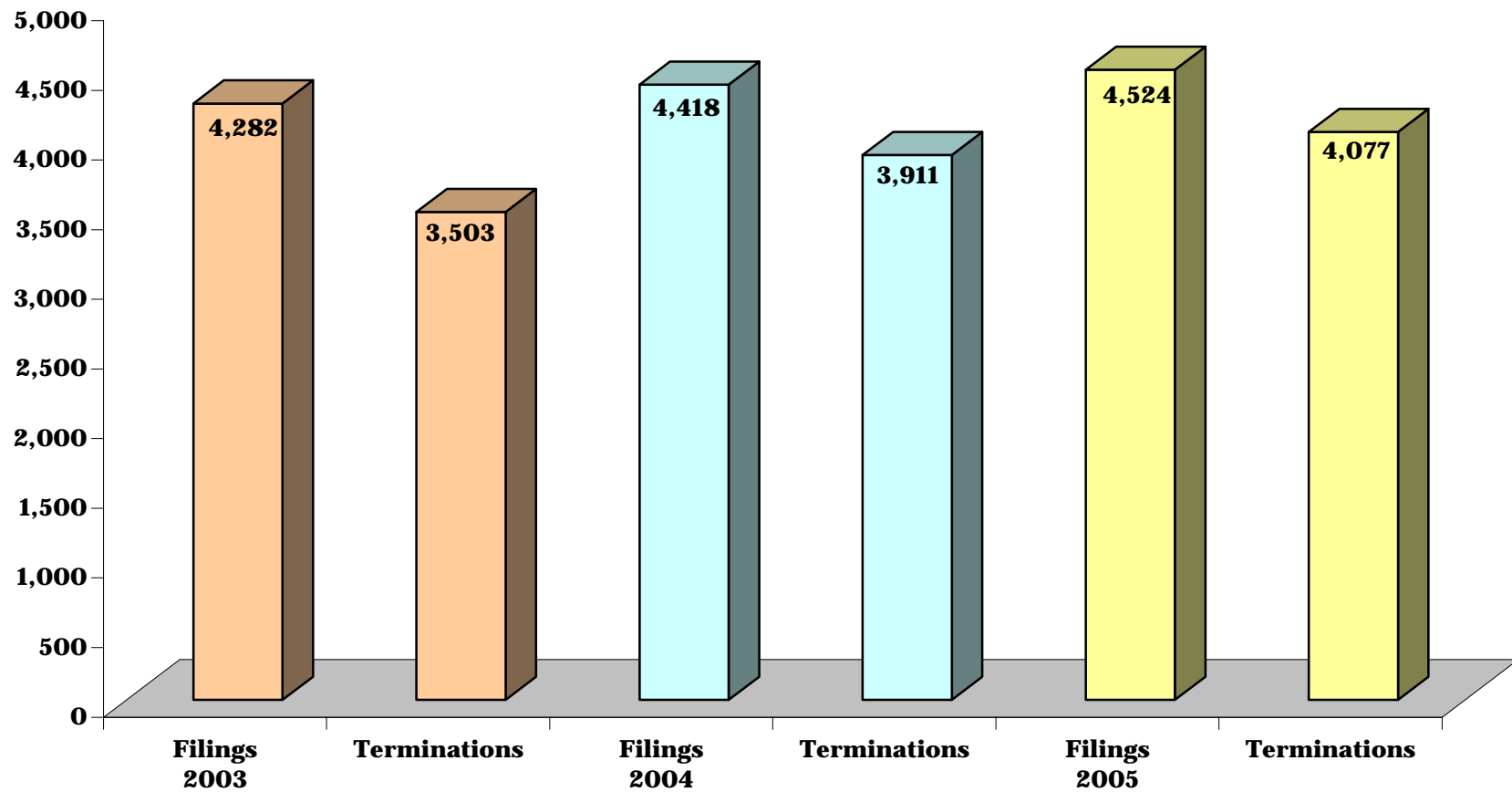

Anne Arundel, Carroll and Howard Counties**

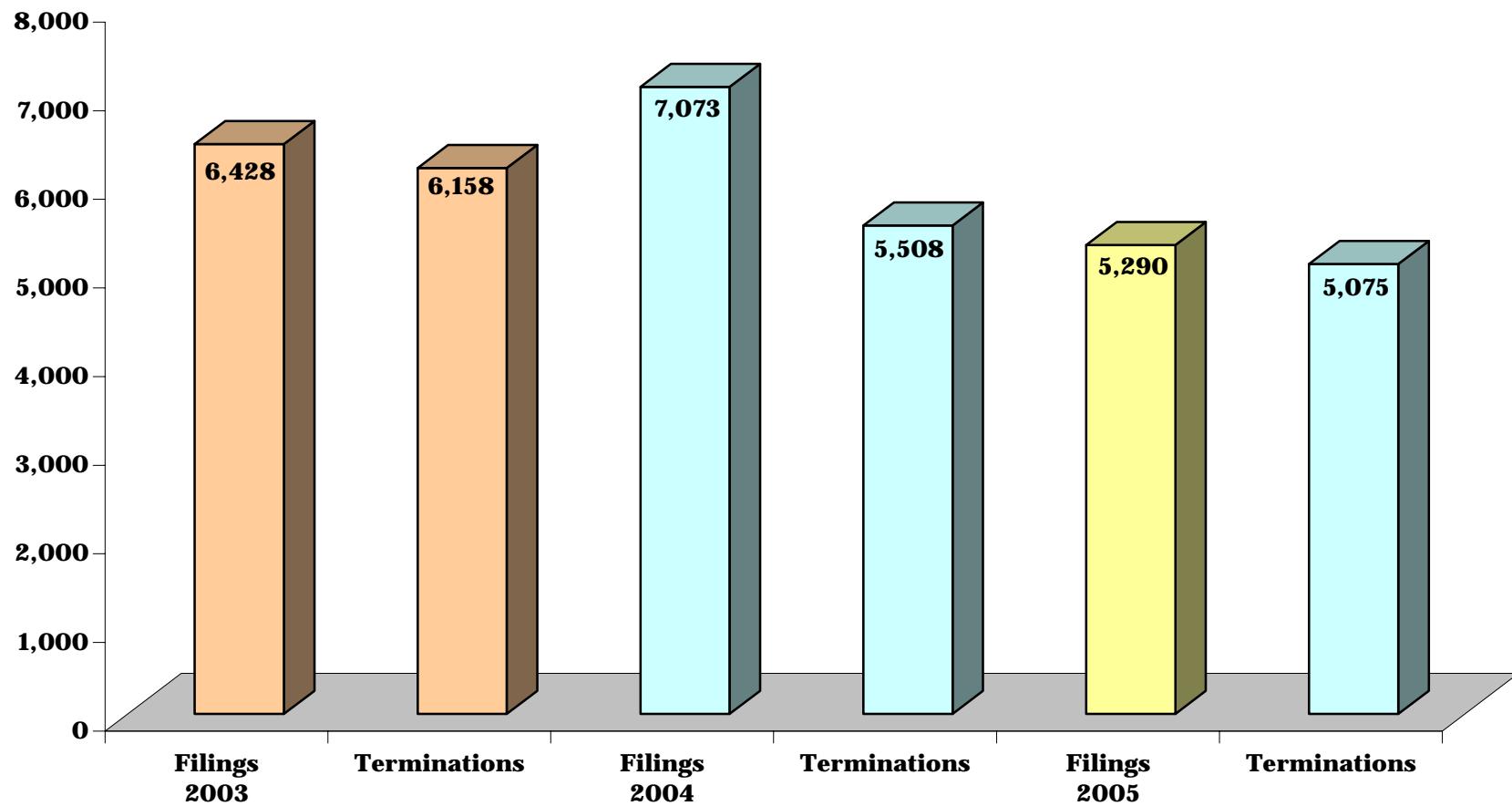

Frederick and Montgomery Counties**

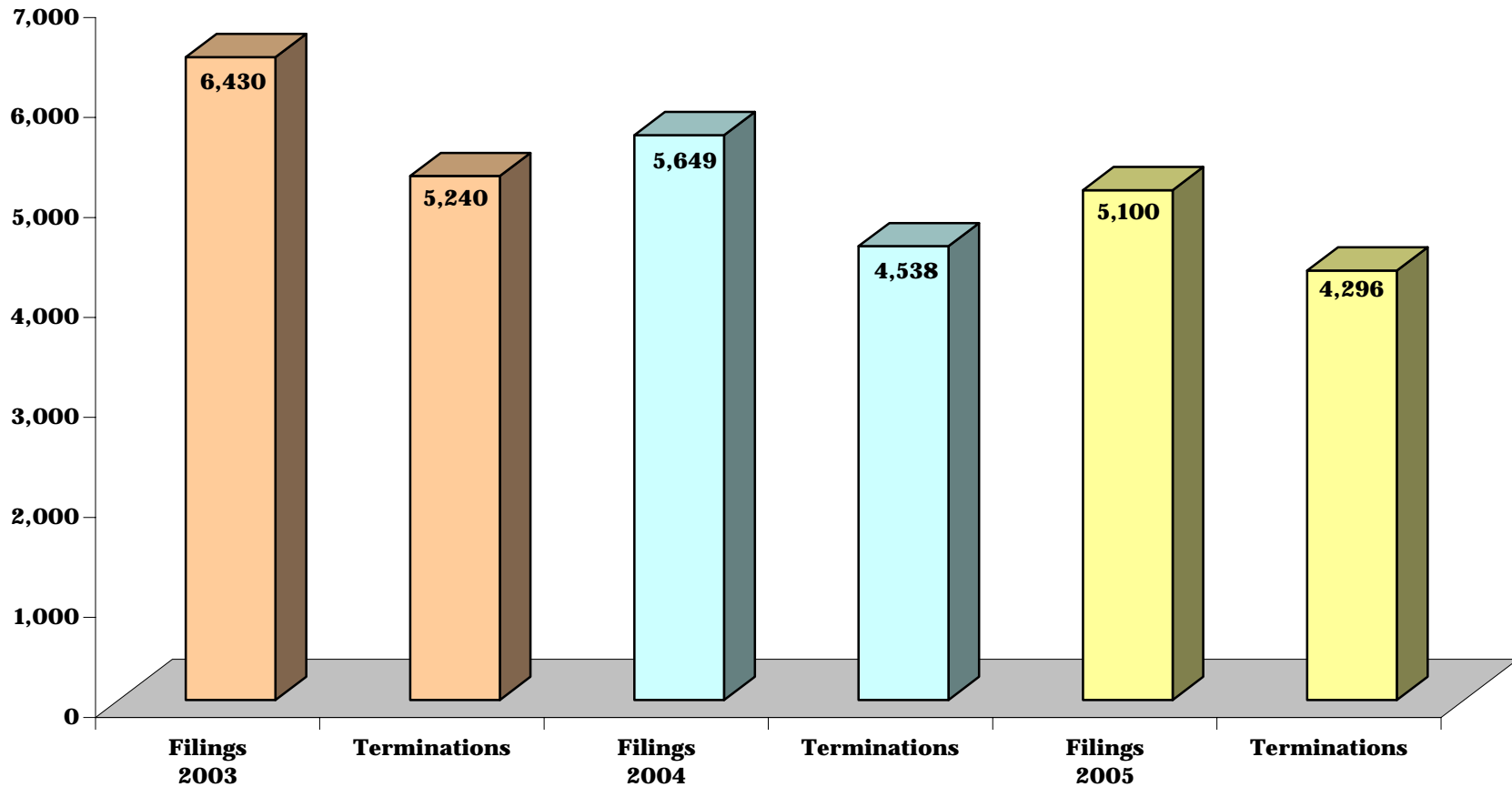

Calvert, Charles, Prince George's and St. Mary's Counties**

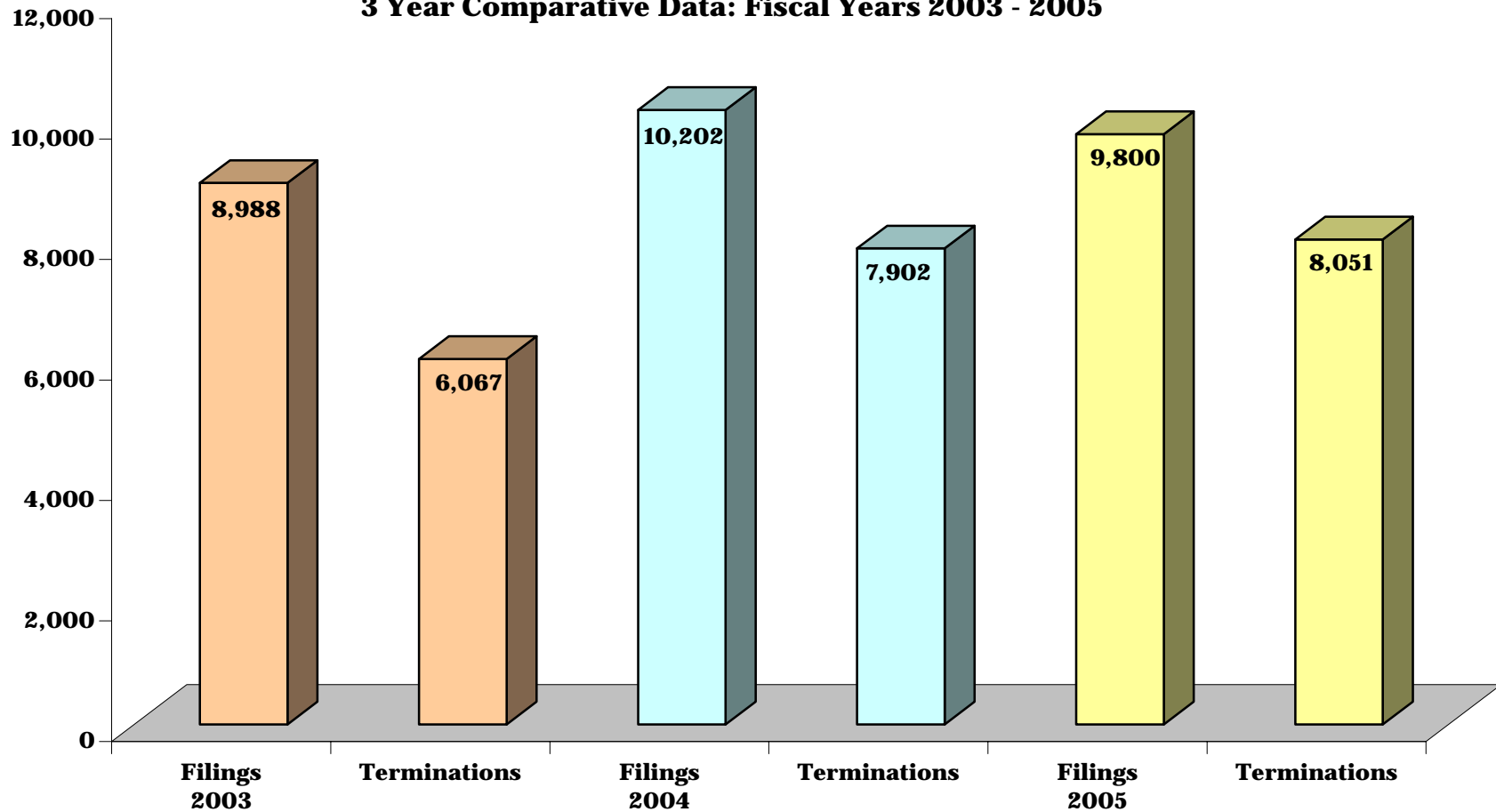

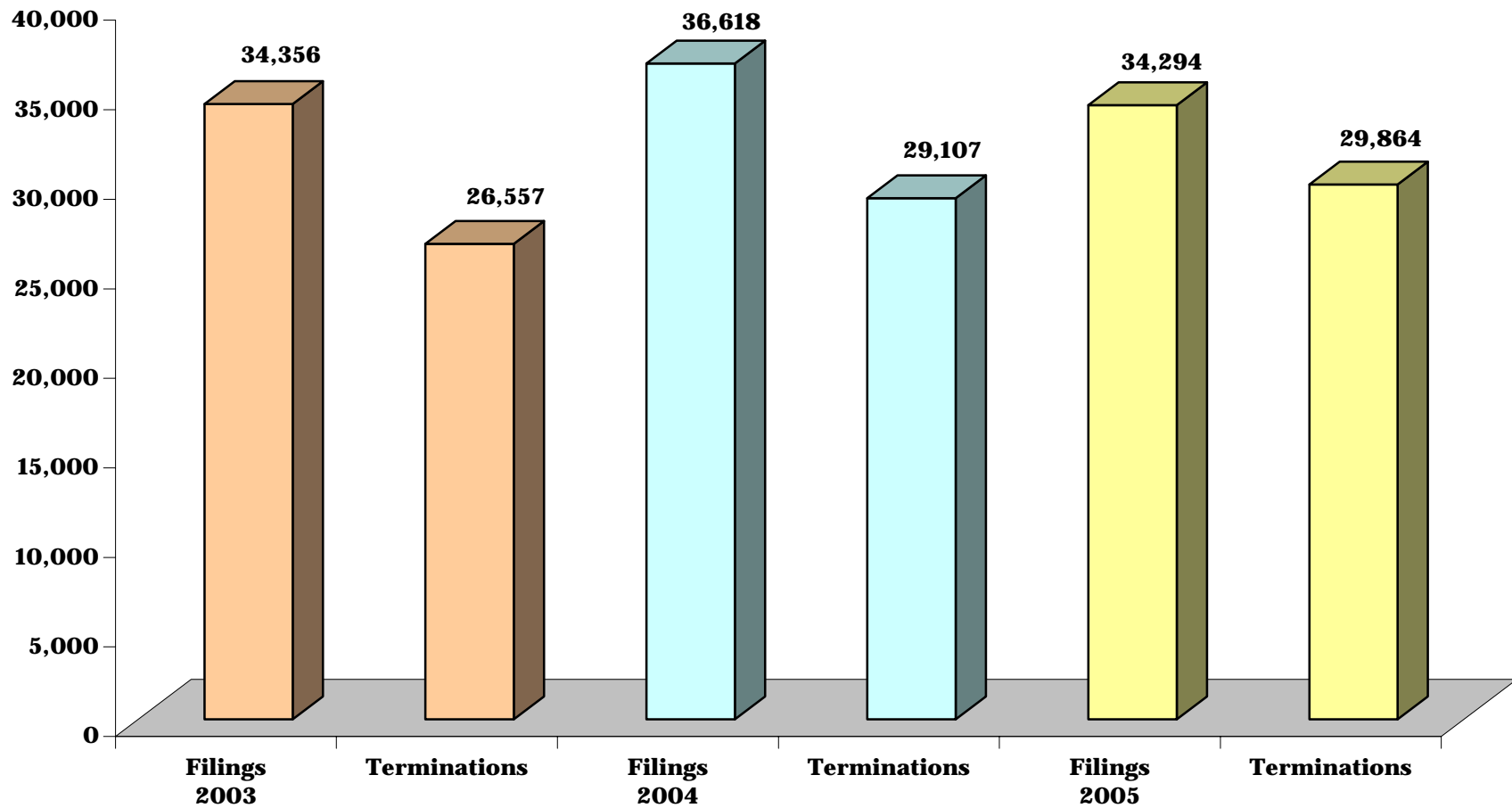

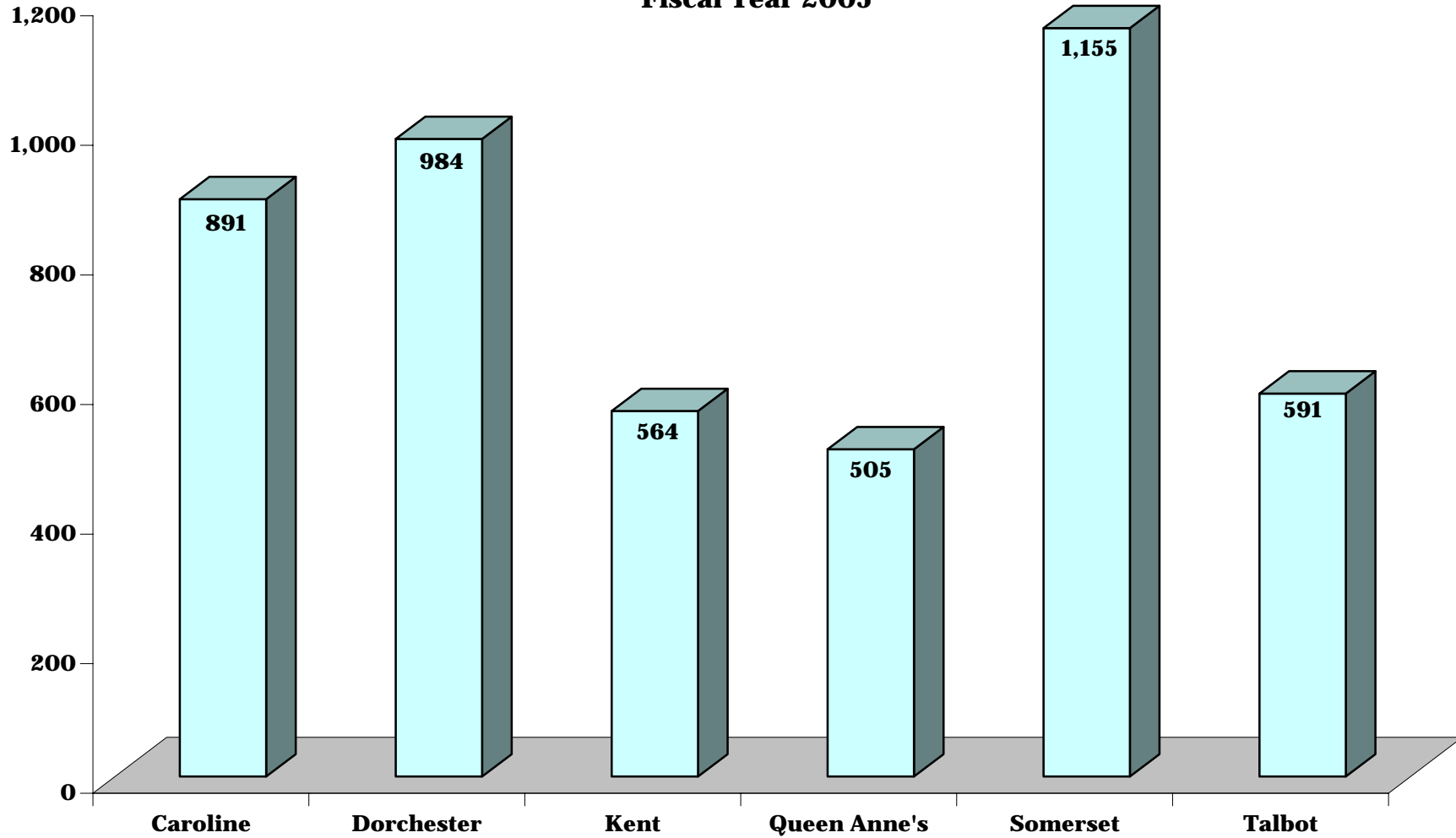

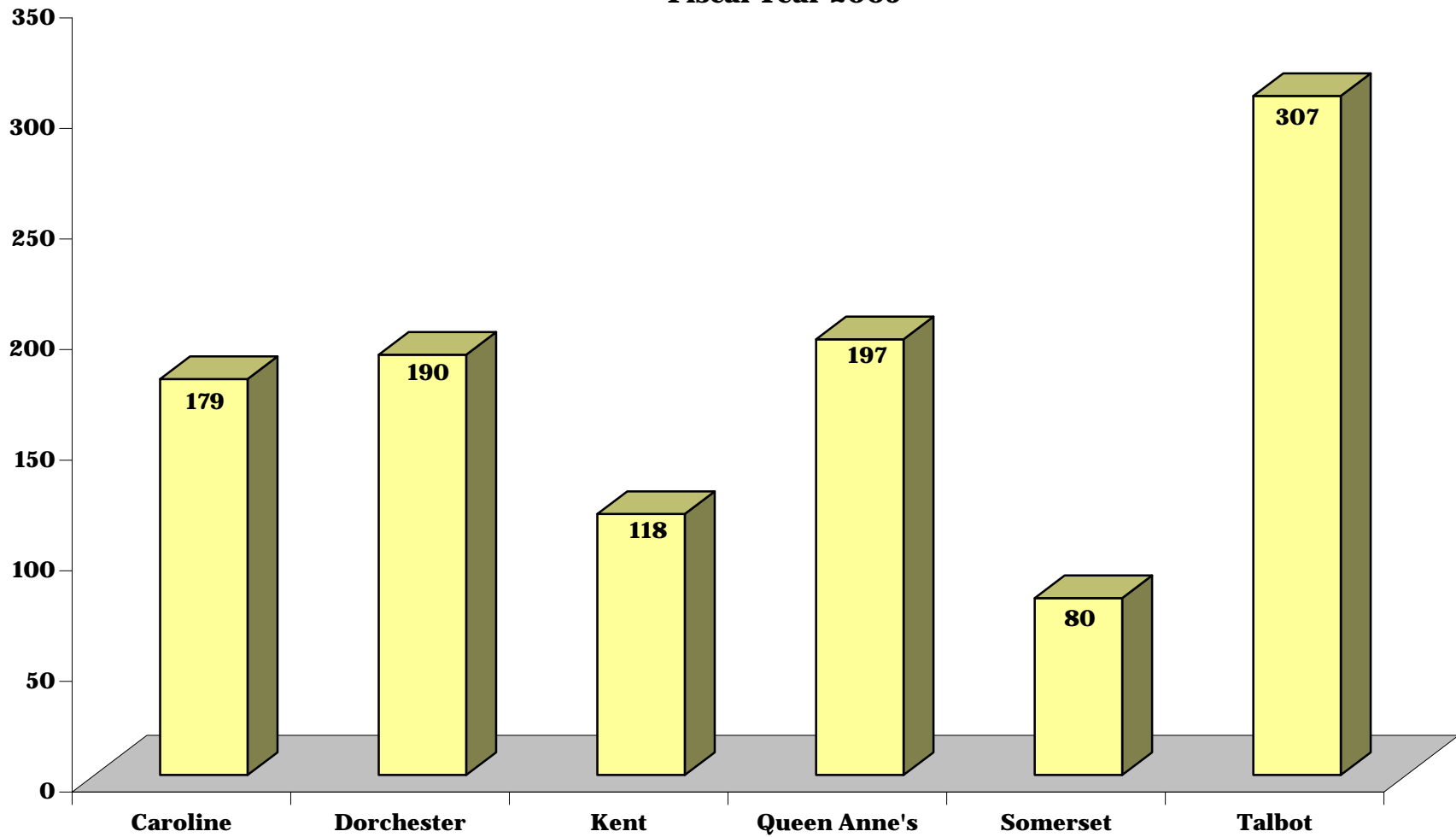

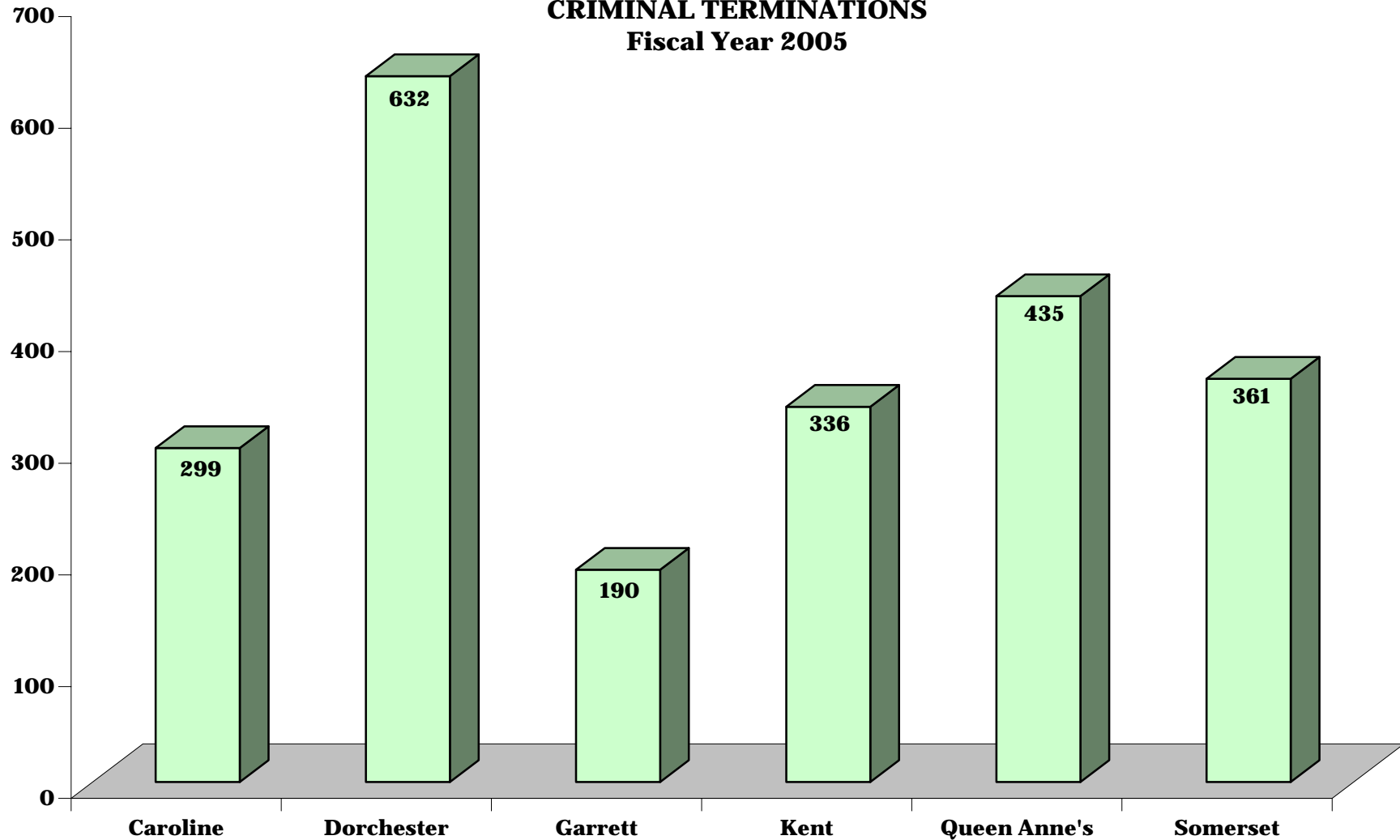

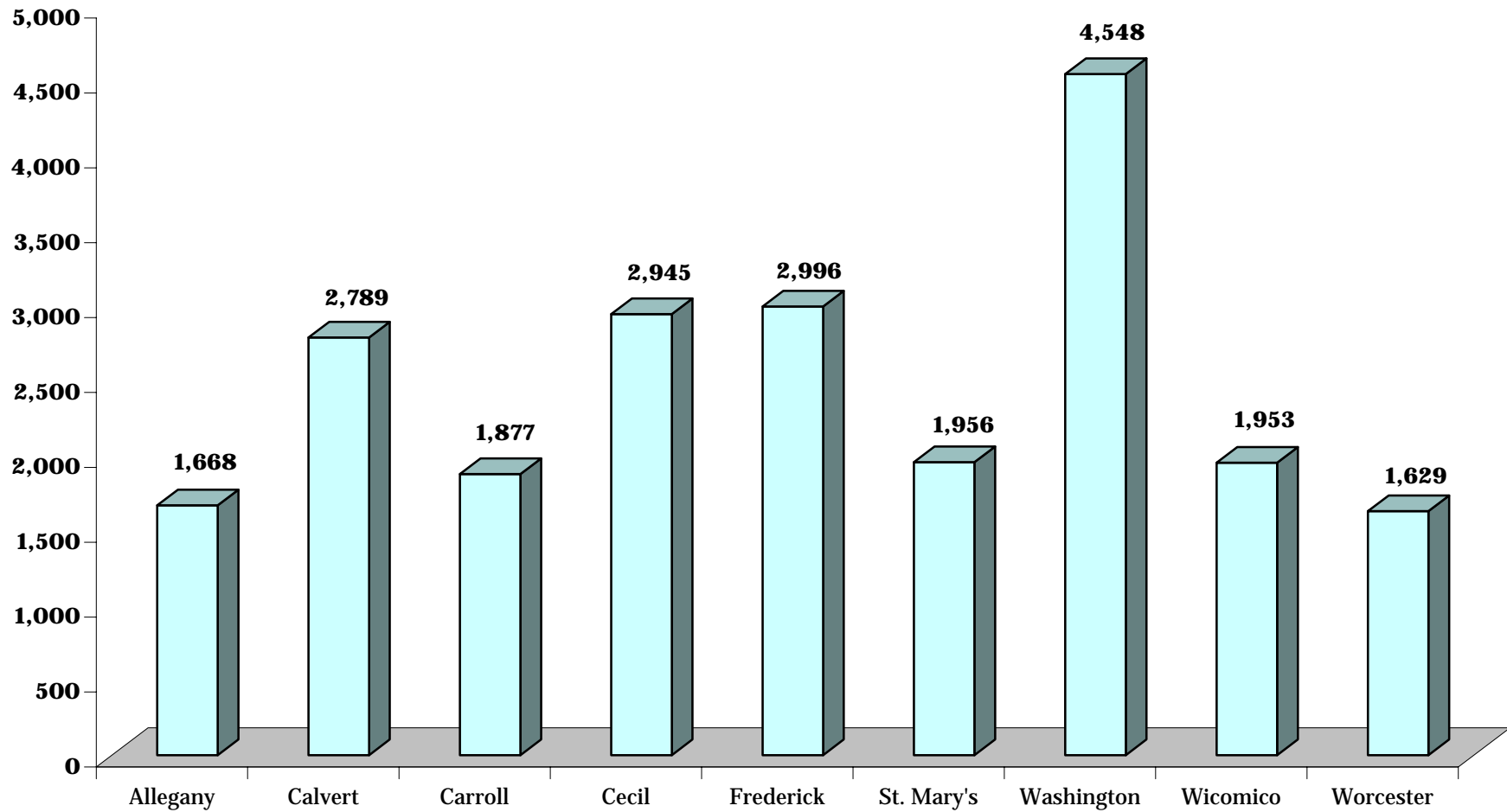

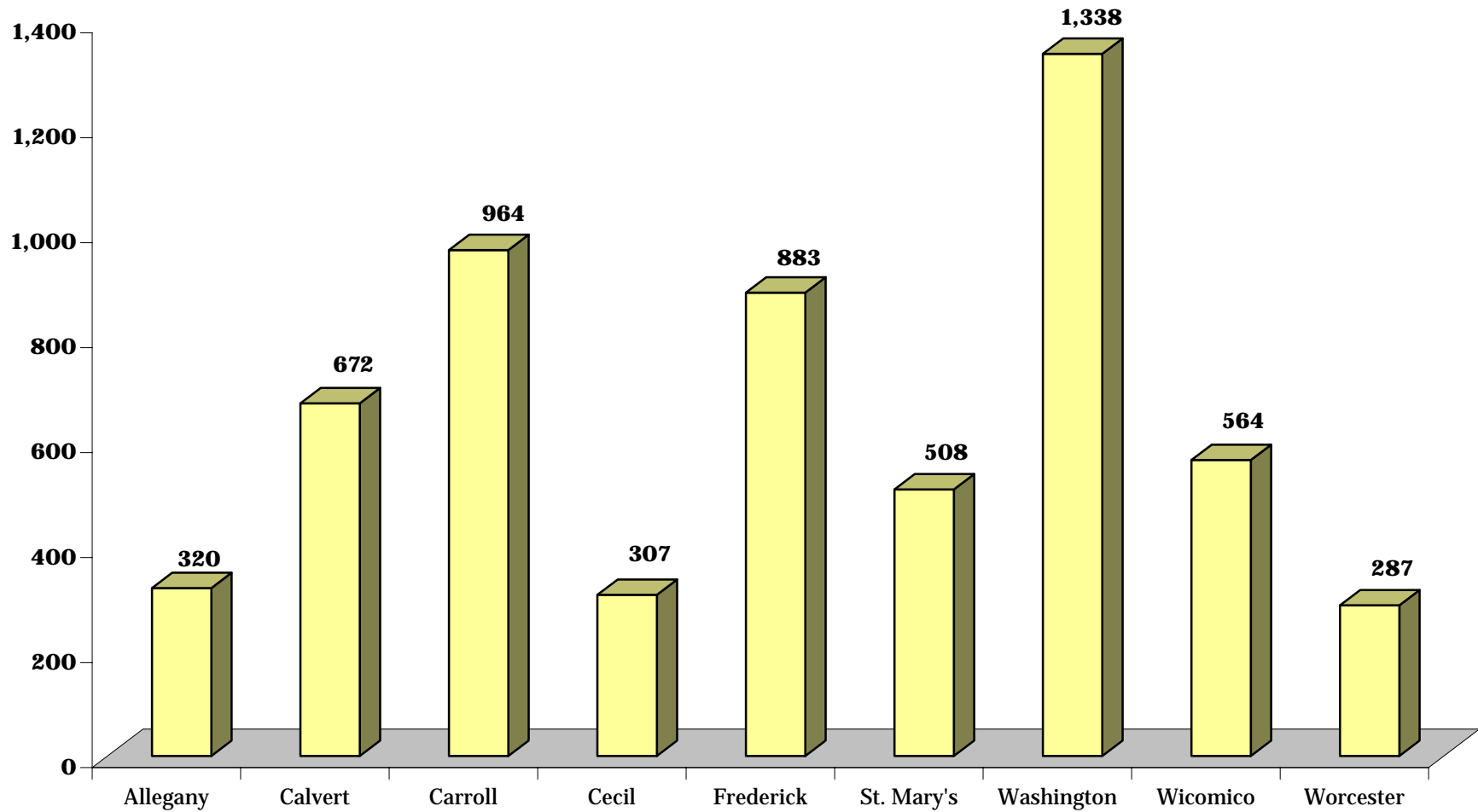

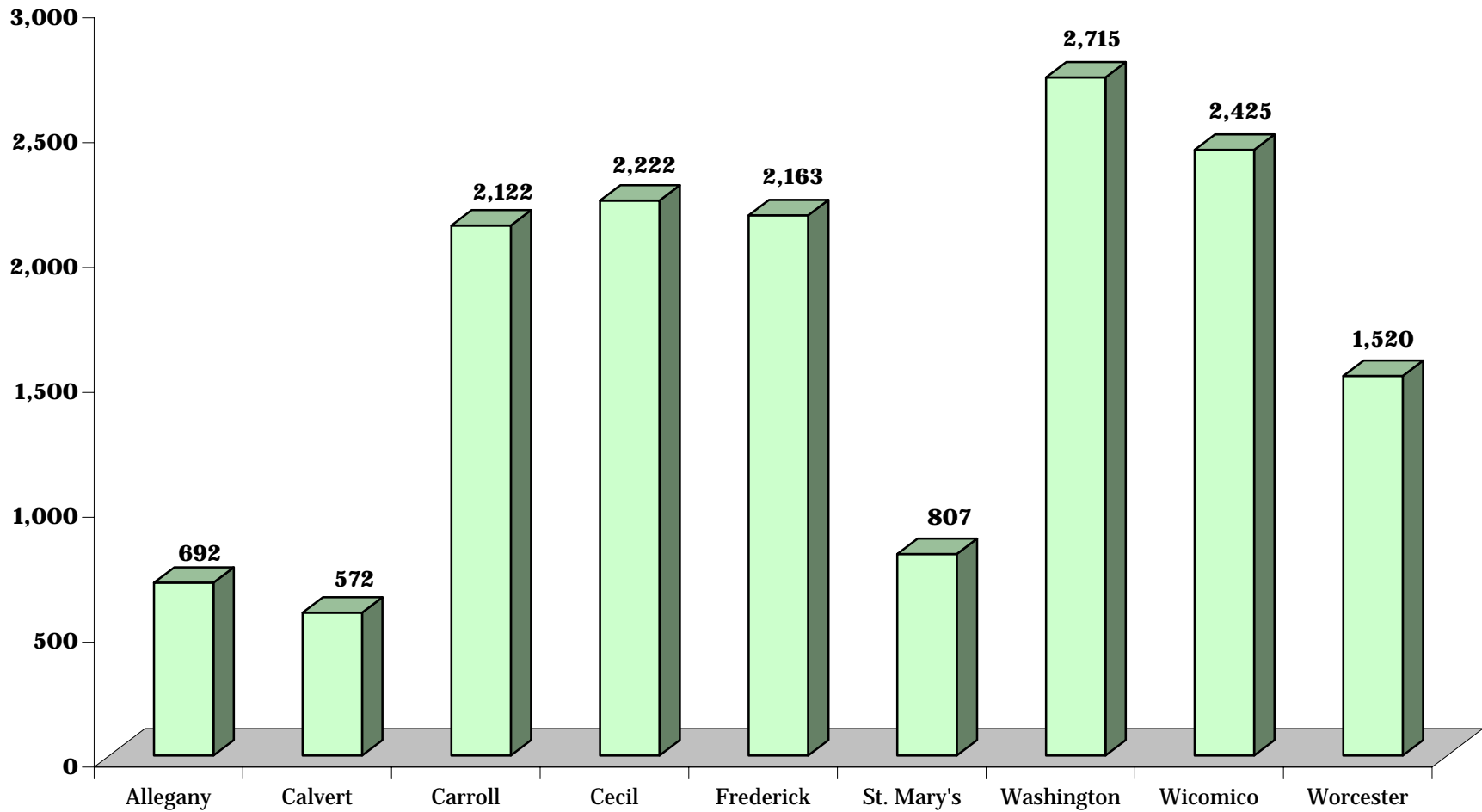

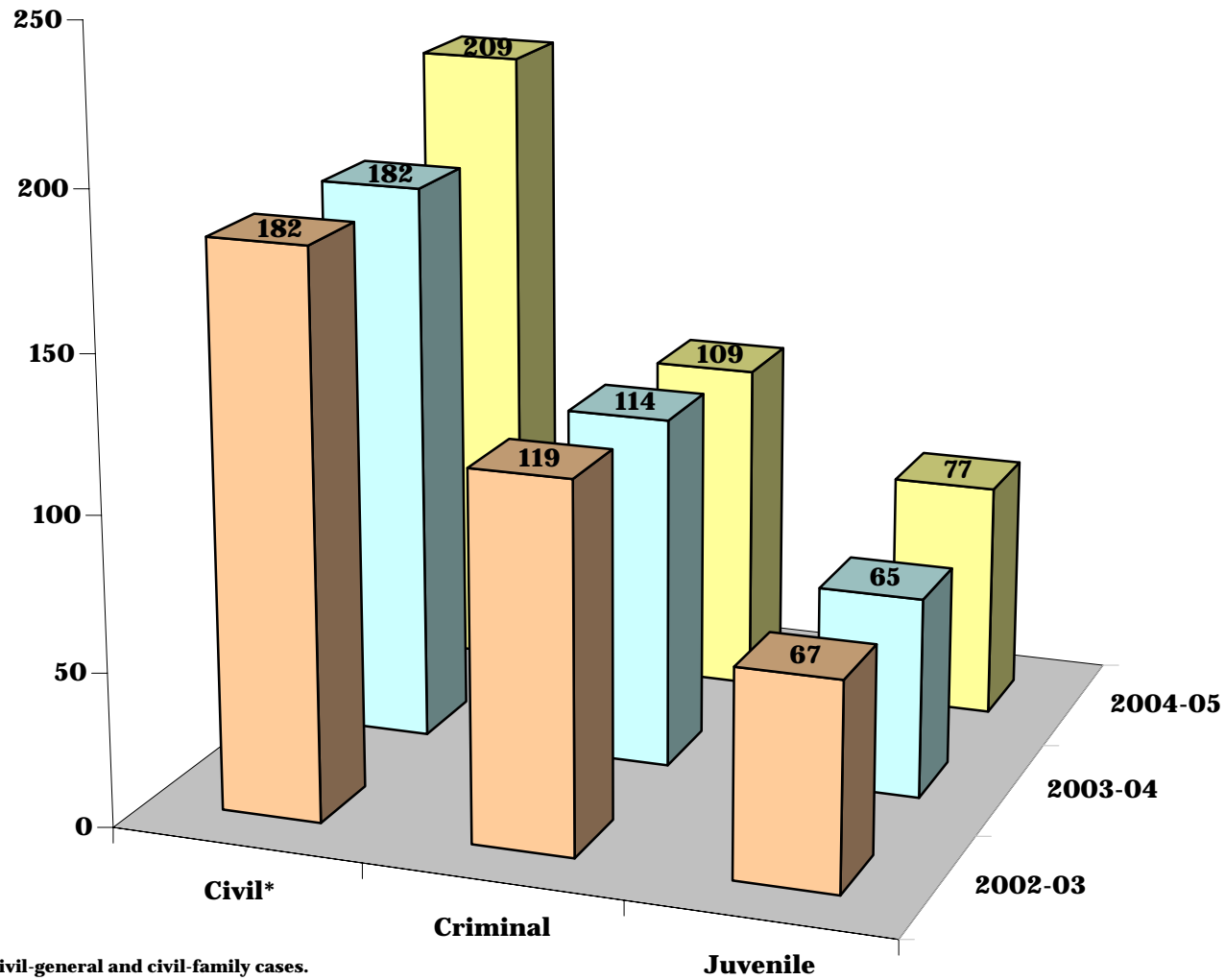

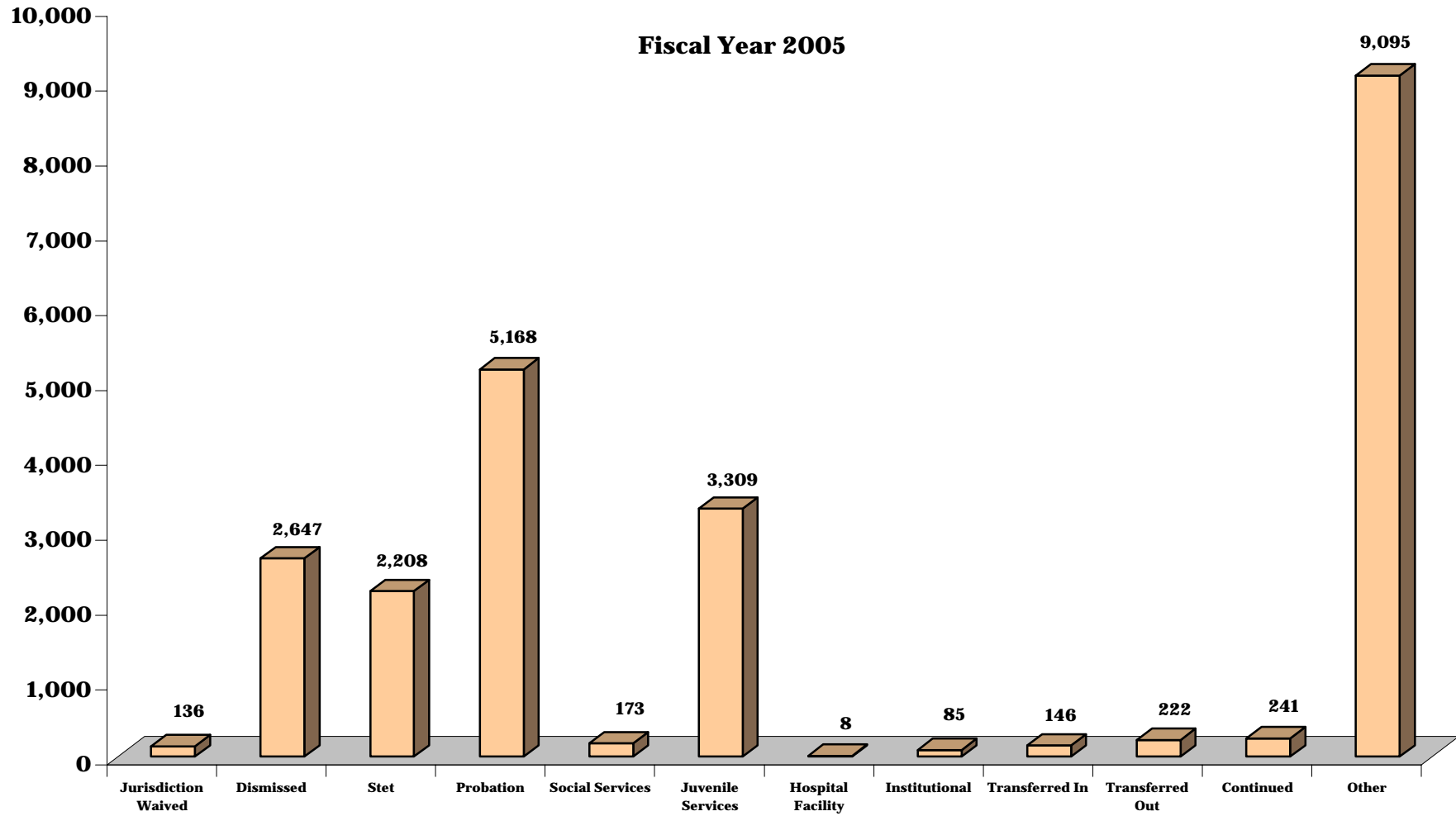

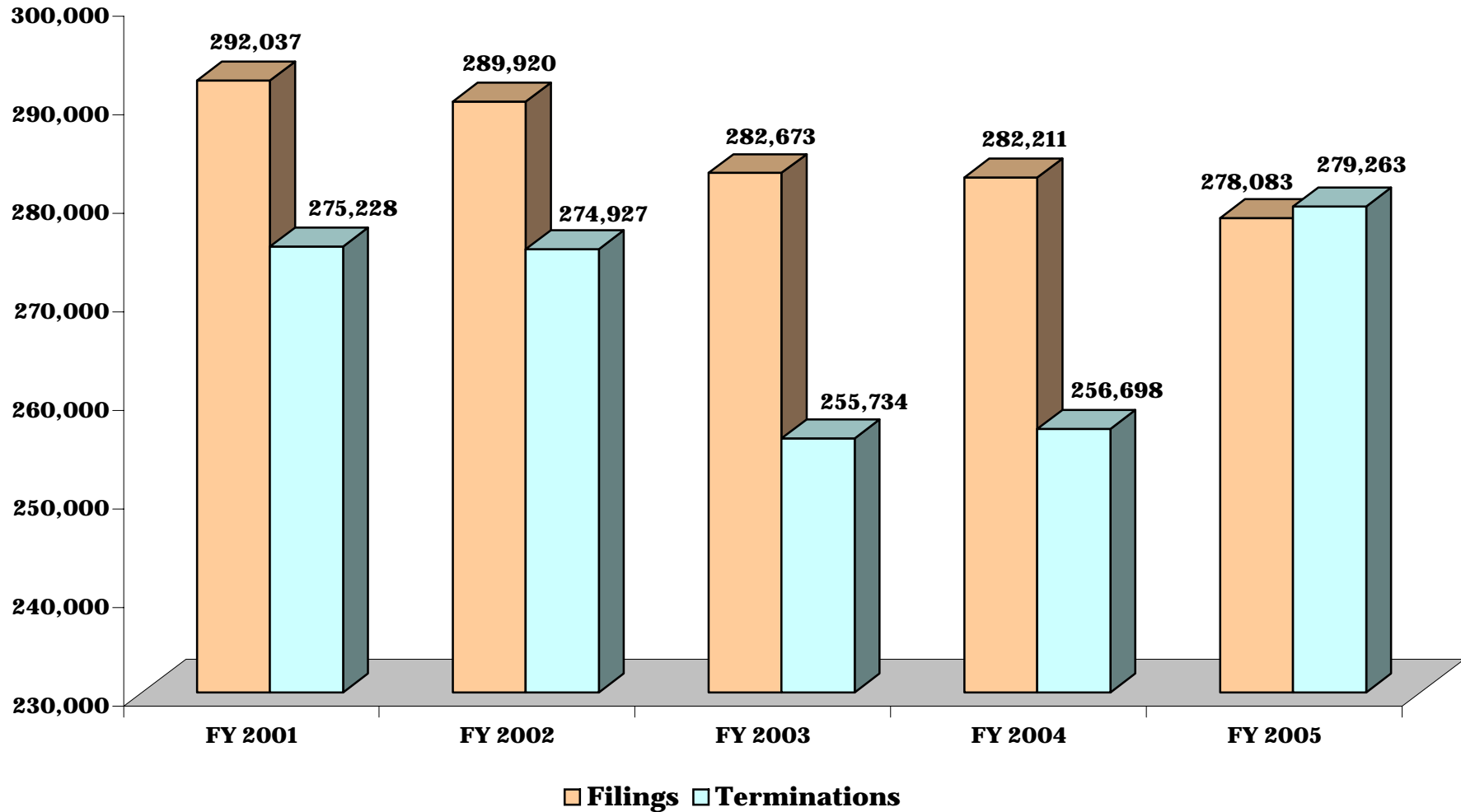

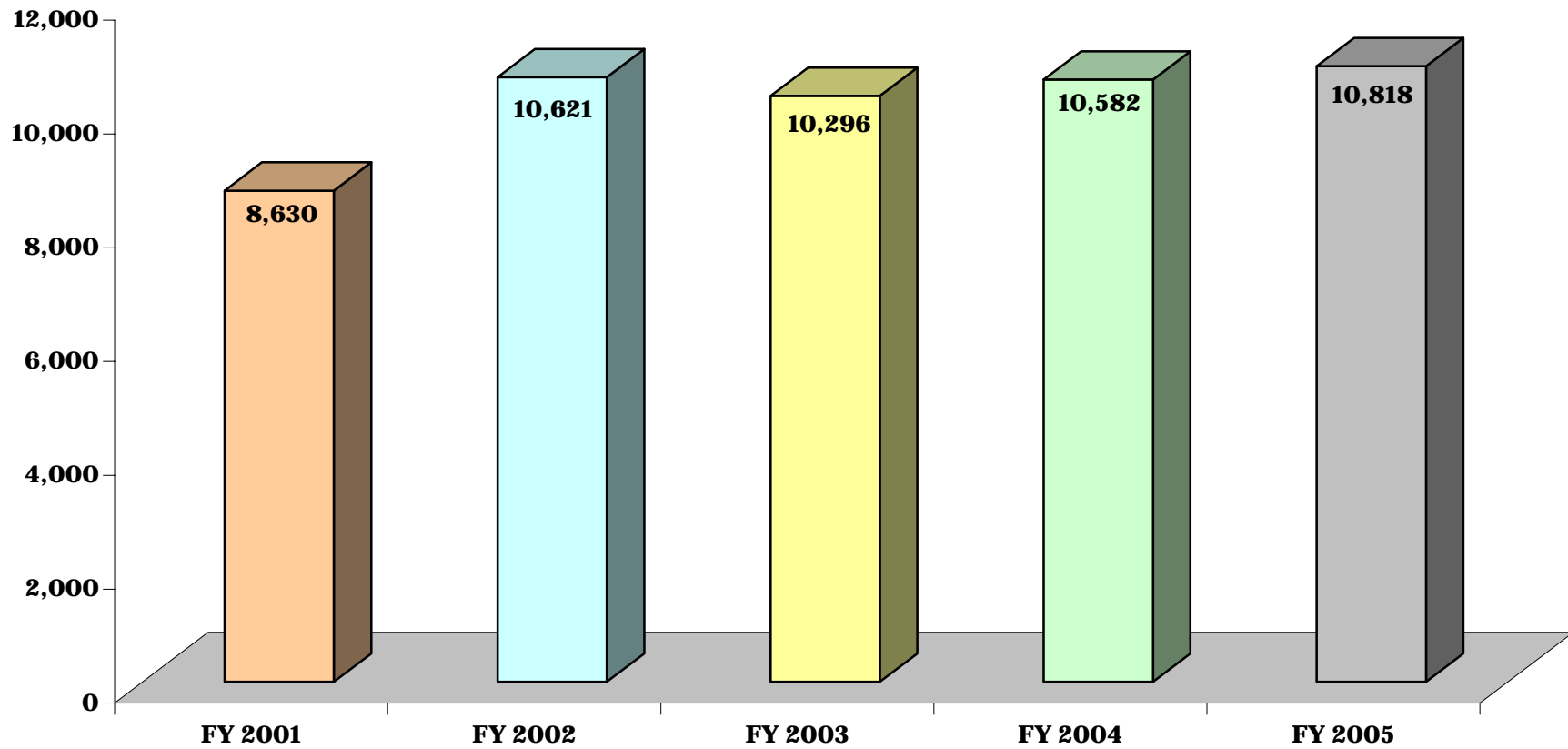

BALTIMORE CITY**

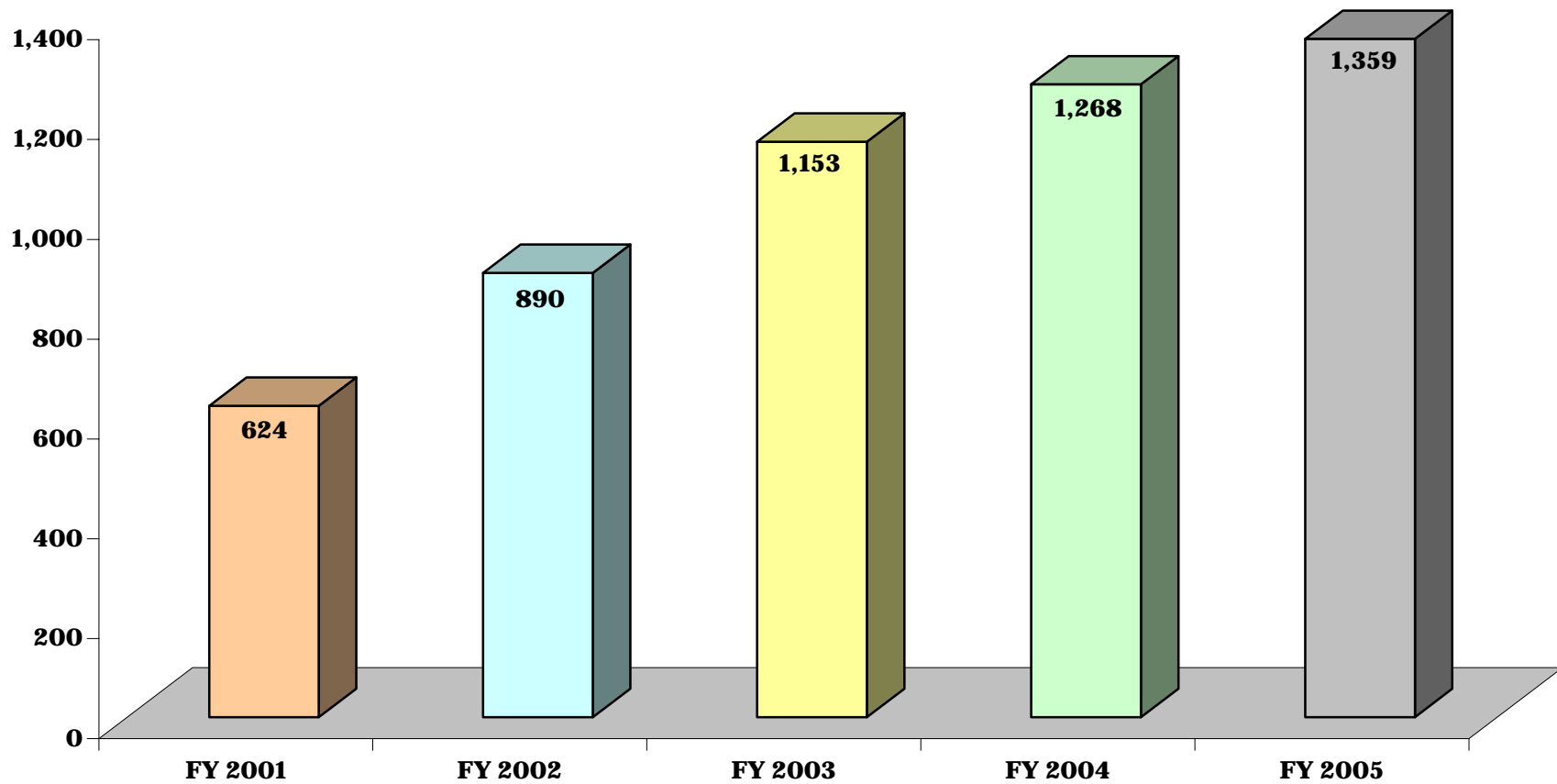

ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY**

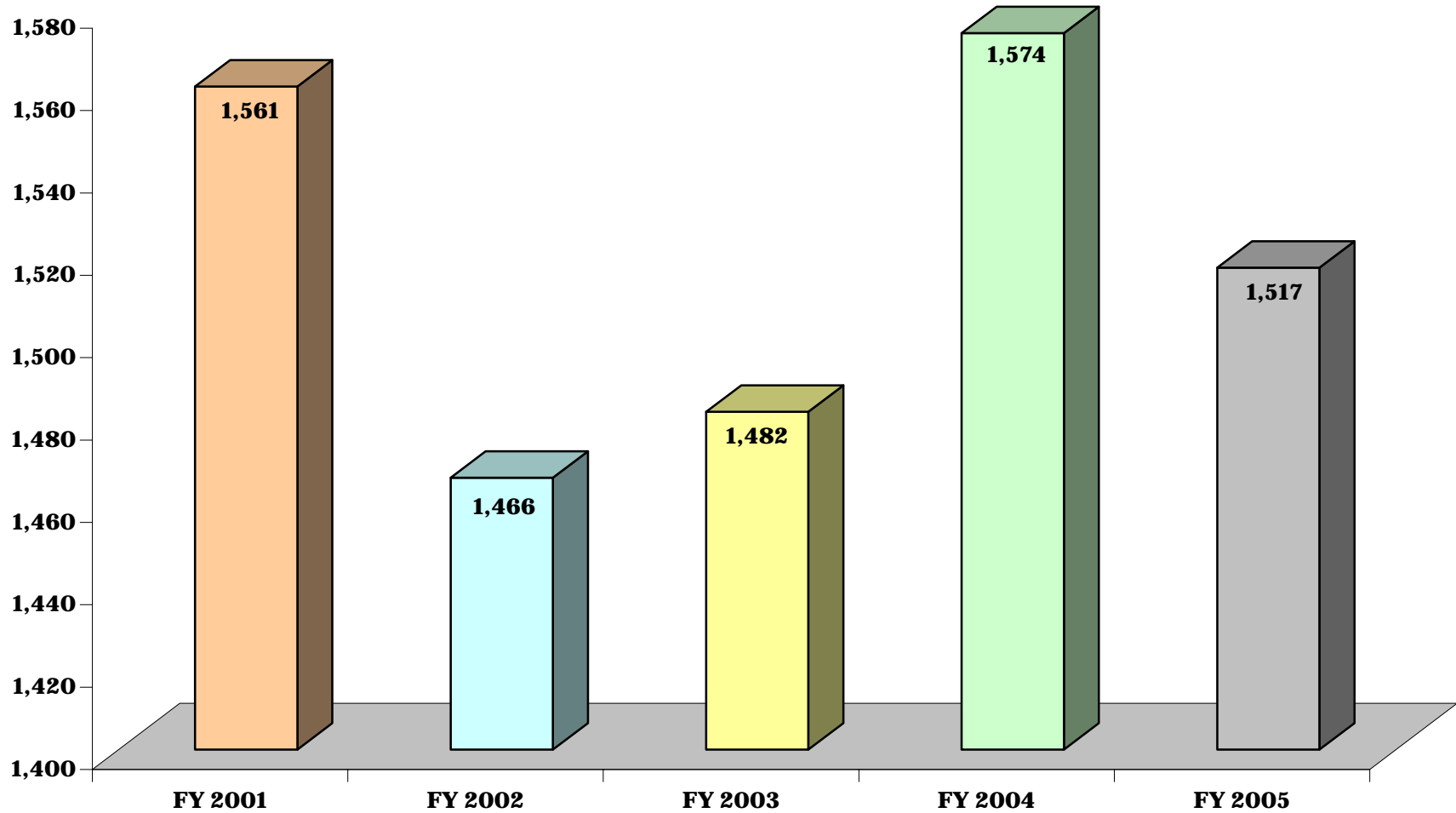

BALTIMORE COUNTY**

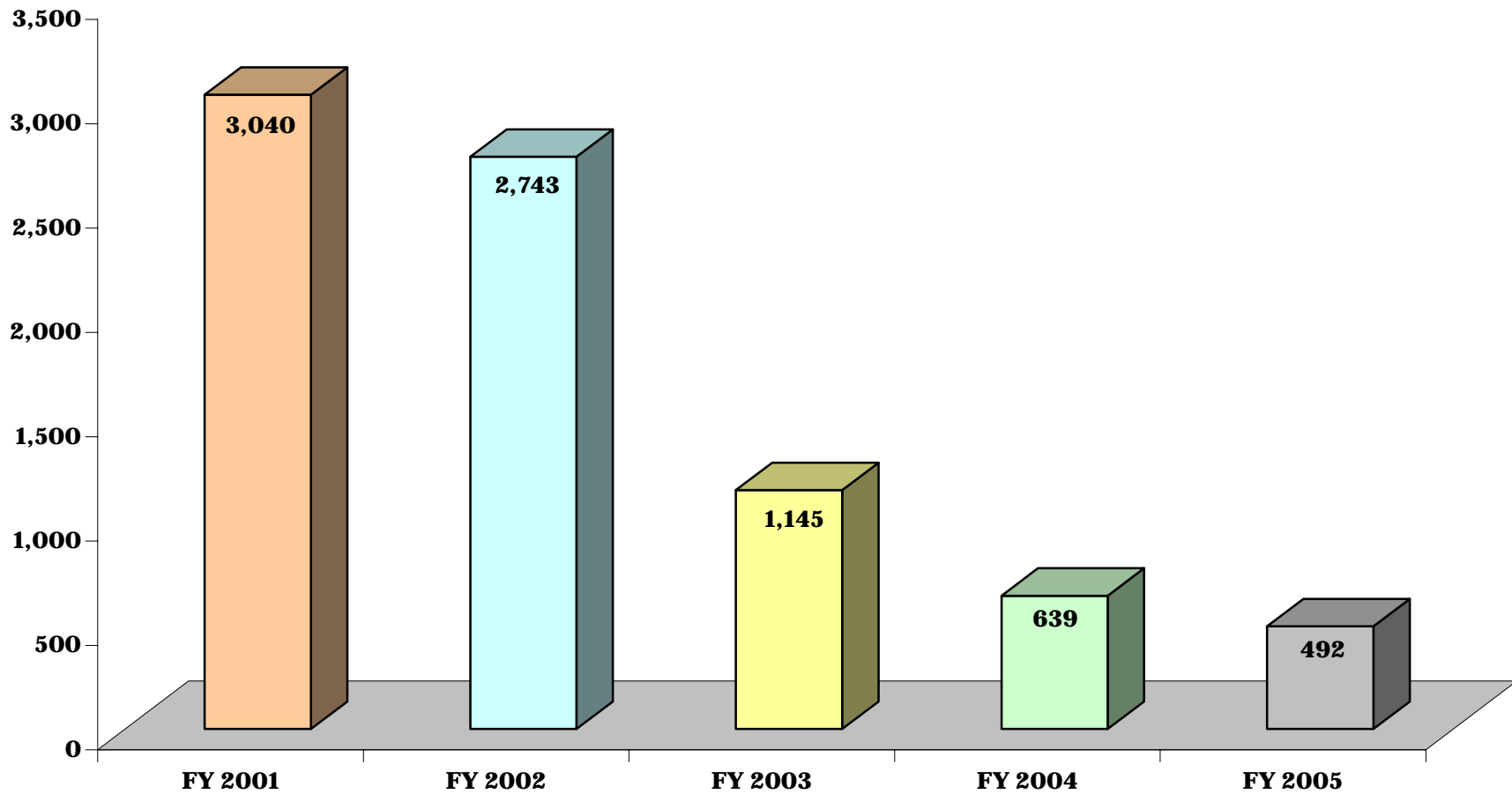

MONTGOMERY COUNTY**

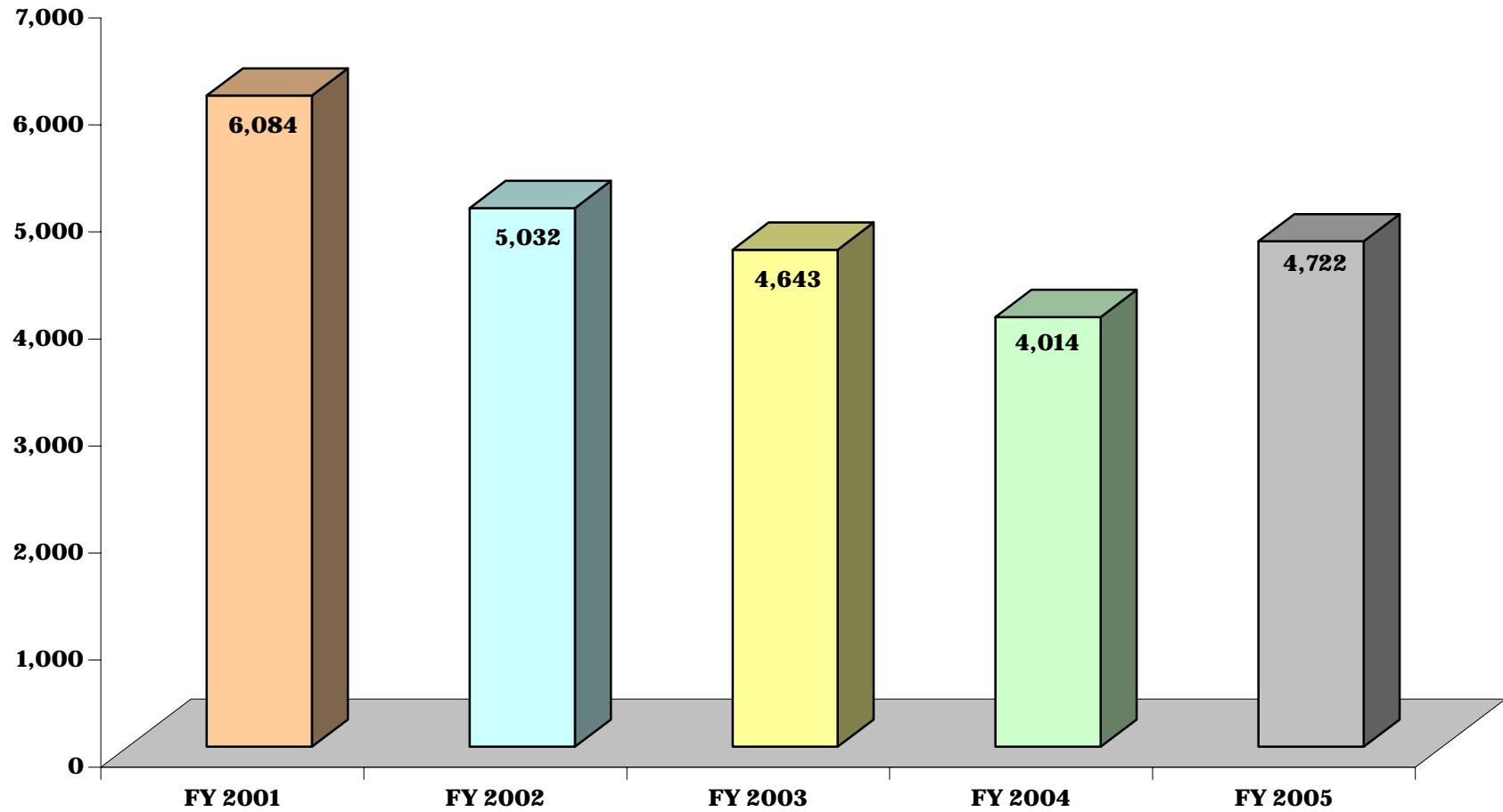

PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY**

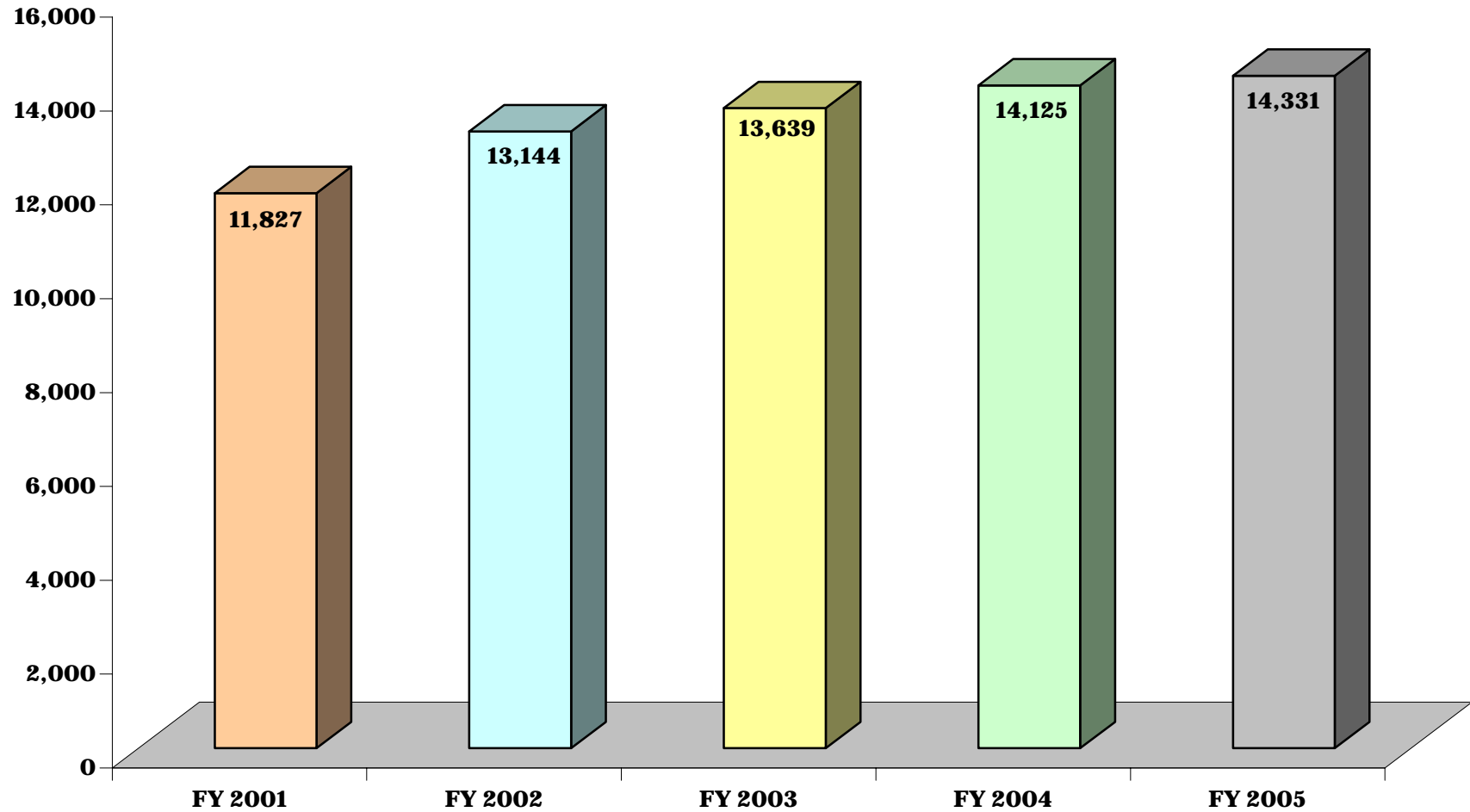

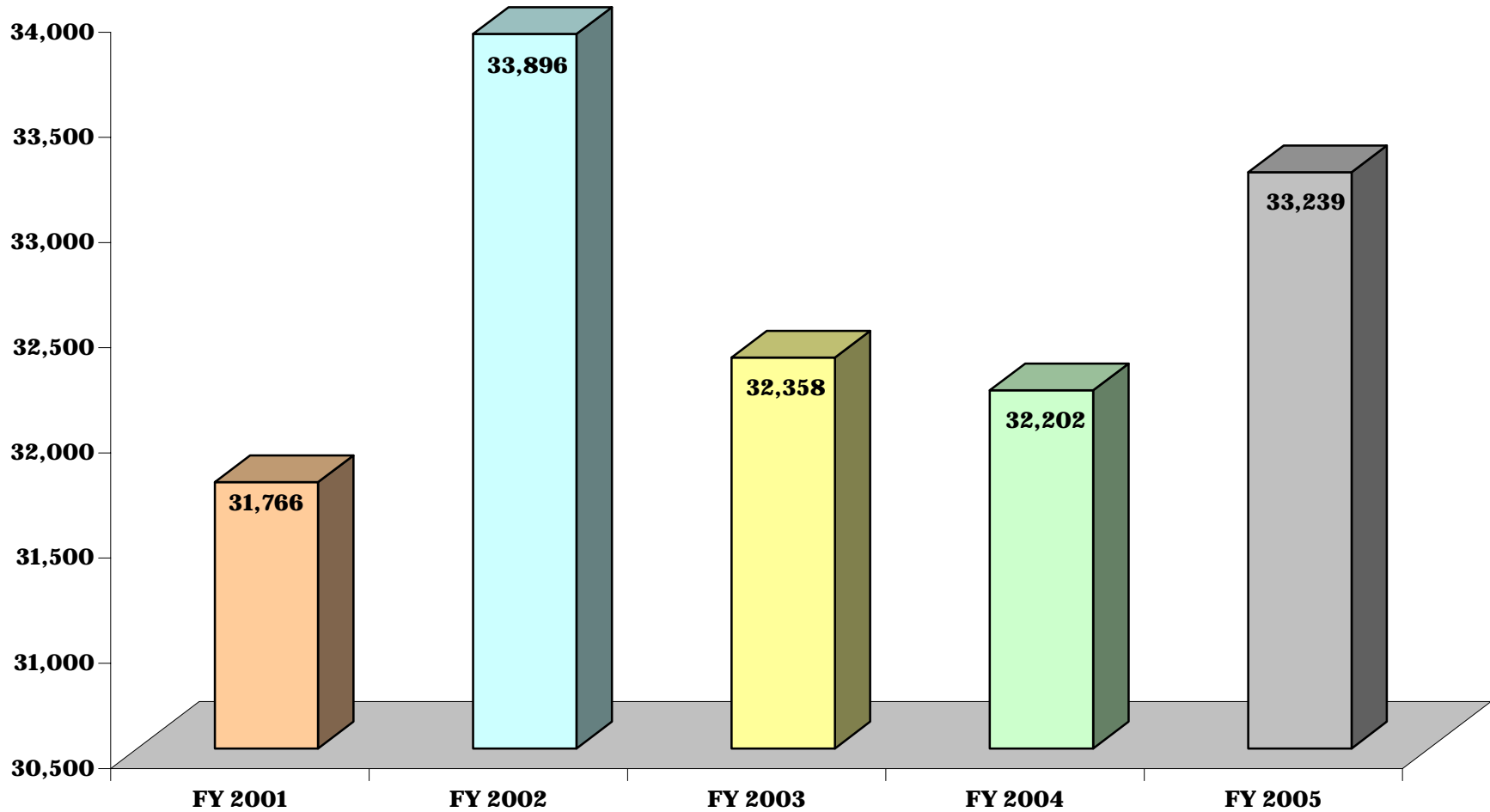

STATE TOTALS**

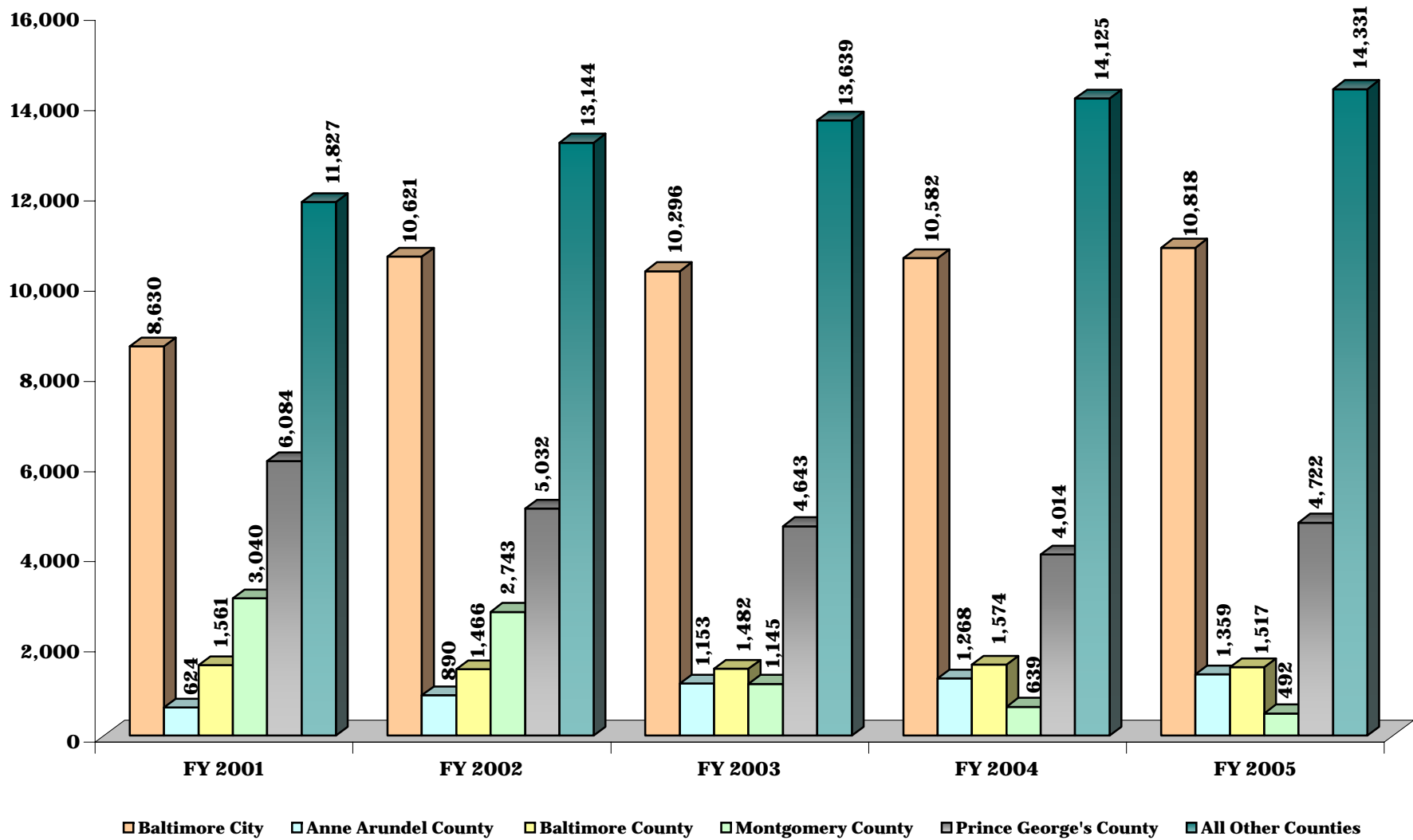
